

Registered parishioners are asked to make arrangements for the Baptismal Preparation Class and the Liturgical Celebration by calling the Parish Office.

Order of Christian Initiation of Adults (OCIA): This process for becoming Catholic is a series of steps conducted in the context of learning about the faith and spiritual formation, through which a person is fully incorporated in the Body of Christ, the Church. This formation is for the unbaptized, those baptized in other Christian communities, and Catholics who have not received all three Sacraments of Initiation (Baptism, Confirmation and Eucharist).

Penance: The Sacrament of Penance is celebrated every Saturday from 3:00 p.m. until 4:00 p.m., during a Communal Penance Service during Advent and Lent *or by appointment*.

Holy Orders: When a gentleman feels the call to follow the Lord as a Priest in the Catholic Church, he should call Father David Kidd, our Diocesan Vocation Director, at 419-244-6711 or email: <u>dkidd@toledodiocese.org</u>, or speak to one of the Parish Priests. If the Permanent Diaconate is of interest to a gentleman, he should call Deacon Daniel Brahier, our Delegate for Deacons, at

419-244-6711 or speak to one of the Deacons of the Parish. **Religious Life:** Consecrated women and men religious by their lives witness the joy of eternal union with God. Freed from earthly cares, they more fully manifest the Kingdom of God to all Christians. The structure of the vowed life frees consecrated religious to live entirely for God and others. Matrimony: Anyone planning to be married must contact the Parish at least six months in advance. The exact date and time of your wedding should not be determined until after consultation with a Priest or Deacon. If either party has previously been civilly or religiously married, the Presider is not permitted to set a date for the wedding without resolving the previous marriage.

Pastoral Care of the Sick: When a parishioner is confined to home because of age or infirmity, please call the Parish Office to arrange for Holy Communion at home. When a parishioner is in a hospital or nursing home, please call the Parish Office to arrange for a visit. You may wish to call before any planned surgeries. When one is seriously ill, the healing Presence of the Lord should be requested in the Sacrament of the Sick by calling the Parish Office at 419-885-5791. Please call, do not email in urgent situations.

Greetings in Christ!

A Note About the Notes: Our sending song today is loved by many for its contemporary yet stately hymnlike melody. The tune was composed by Gustov Holst as a movement in his orchestral suite, *The Planets* (1914-1916). Holst adapted the theme in 1921 (named Thaxted for his hometown) and set it to patriotic lyrics. In 1982, Michael Perry wrote two sacred verses to this melody and it became "O God Beyond All

Praising." Prompted by another composer a few years later, Perry wrote a third verse and squeezed it in between the first two. This majestic hymn of praise is beautiful for its use of time in reference to the eternal God. The first verse states that even though God is beyond all praising, beyond payment, beyond generous, beyond merciful, beyond adoration, we worship God *today*. The added verse two describes how our time on earth will eventually end, but Christ is our redeemer and savior. Finally, verse three calls us to put our trust in Christ the King for the future, regardless of what tomorrow brings.


Impromptu Choir






