

Registered parishioners are asked to make arrangements for the Baptismal Preparation Class and the Liturgical Celebration by calling the Parish Office.

Order of Christian Initiation of Adults (OCIA): This process for becoming Catholic is a series of steps conducted in the context of learning about the faith and spiritual formation, through which a person is fully incorporated in the Body of Christ, the Church. This formation is for the unbaptized, those baptized in other Christian communities, and Catholics who have not received all three Sacraments of Initiation (Baptism, Confirmation and Eucharist).

Penance: The Sacrament of Penance is celebrated every Saturday from 3:00 p.m. until 4:00 p.m., during a Communal Penance Service during Advent and Lent *or by appointment*.

Matrimony: Anyone planning to be married must contact the Parish at least six months in advance. The exact date and time of your wedding should not be determined until after consultation with a Priest or Deacon. If either party has previously been civilly or religiously married, the Presider is not permitted to set a date for the wedding without resolving the previous marriage.

Pastoral Care of the Sick: When a parishioner is confined to home because of age or infirmity, please call the Parish Office to arrange for Holy Communion at home. When a parishioner is in a hospital or nursing home, please call the Parish Office to arrange for a visit. You may wish to call before any planned surgeries. When one is seriously ill, the healing Presence of the Lord should be requested in the Sacrament of the Sick by calling the Parish Office at 419-885-5791. Please call, do not email in urgent situations.

Saint Teresa Benedicta of the Cross (Edith Stein)

From the Desk of Maddie Piscopo, **Development Director**

Edith Stein was born in 1891 to a Jewish family living in Breslau, Germany. From a very young age, she was intellectually curious and loved to learn. She was a brilliant university student and graduated summa cum laude with a doctoral degree in philosophy.

In 1921, Edith had a conversion experience. At age 30, she began reading the autobiography of Saint Teresa of Avila in a friend's library and couldn't put it down. "This is the truth!"



she exclaimed. She converted to Catholicism and was baptized on New Year's Day, 1922. Edith soon became well regarded as a Catholic philosopher and author.

Edith was passionate about her teaching, writing and lectures, and she vearned for a deeper relationship with God.


