Infant Baptism: The Sacrament of Baptism is celebrated after the Noon Mass on the Second and Fourth Sundays of the month. Registered parishioners are asked to make arrangements for the Baptismal Preparation Class and the Liturgical Celebration by calling the Parish Office.

Order of Christian Initiation of Adults (OCIA): This process for becoming Catholic is a series of steps conducted in the context of learning about the faith and spiritual formation, through which a person is fully incorporated in the Body of Christ, the Church. This formation is for the unbaptized, those baptized in other Christian communities, and Catholics who have not received all three Sacraments of Initiation (Baptism, Confirmation and Eucharist).

Penance: The Sacrament of Penance is celebrated every Saturday from 3:00 p.m. until 4:00 p.m., during a Communal Penance Service during Advent and Lent or by appointment.

Holy Orders: When a gentleman feels the call to follow the Lord as a Priest in the Catholic Church, he should call Father David Kidd, our Diocesan Vocation Director, at 419-244-6711 or email: dkidd@toledodiocese.org, or speak to one of the Parish Priests. If the Permanent Diaconate is of interest to a gentleman, he should call Deacon Daniel Brahier, our Delegate for Deacons, at

419-244-6711 or speak to one of the Deacons of the Parish. Religious Life: Consecrated women and men religious by their lives witness the joy of eternal union with God. Freed from earthly cares, they more fully manifest the Kingdom of God to all Christians. The structure of the vowed life frees consecrated religious to live entirely for God and others. Matrimony: Anyone planning to be married must contact the Parish at least six months in advance. The exact date and time of your wedding should not be determined until after consultation with a Priest or Deacon. If either party has previously been civilly or religiously married, the Presider is not permitted to set a date for the wedding without resolving the previous marriage.

Pastoral Care of the Sick: When a parishioner is confined to home because of age or infirmity, please call the Parish Office to arrange for Holy Communion at home. When a parishioner is in a hospital or nursing home, please call the Parish Office to arrange for a visit. You may wish to call before any planned surgeries. When one is seriously ill, the healing Presence of the Lord should be requested in the Sacrament of the Sick by calling the Parish Office at 419-885-5791. Please call, do not email in urgent situations.

WORSHIP: Worship is the response of the People of God to the Father's invitation to be one with Him, expressed through the Church's official liturgy, as well as through other prayers and devotions. Our worship is direct to the Father, through the Son, in the unity of the Holy Spirit. All the ministries related to the prayer of the Church are included in this category.



Thousands of pilgrims filled the streets of Carey, Ohio, for Diocese the annual Vigil of the Assumption of the Blessed Virgin Mary at the Basilica and National Shrine of Our Lady of Consolation. The candlelight Rosary procession, led by

Bishop Daniel E. Thomas, wound its way to the outdoor altar in Shrine Park, where the Vigil Mass was celebrated under the summer night sky. The beloved tradition draws faithful from across the Diocese of Toledo and beyond each August 14, honoring Mary on the eve of her Assumption into Heaven. Pilgrims carried candles as they prayed the Rosary, accompanying the miraculous statue of Our Lady of Consolation in a moving display of devotion.

Bishop Thomas reflected on the significance of the evening: "It's such a beautiful way to honor Our Lady, to gather together, to be moved by the devotion before that miraculous image and statue of Our Lady, to pray the Rosary, to attend Holy Mass and receive the Holy Eucharist, and to honor Mary, the mother of Christ Jesus, in her Assumption into Heaven." As the Rosary concluded, the faithful processed back to the basilica in the warm August night. Bishop Thomas was joined by all of the diocese's seminarians, along with priests, religious, and laypeople who have made the procession an annual act of faith.

For many, the Vigil of the Assumption remains one of the most cherished celebrations of the year - a living witness of love for Mary and, through her, for her Son, Jesus Christ.
