

Registered parishioners are asked to make arrangements for the Baptismal Preparation Class and the Liturgical Celebration by calling the Parish Office.

**Order of Christian Initiation of Adults (OCIA):** This process for becoming Catholic is a series of steps conducted in the context of learning about the faith and spiritual formation, through which a person is fully incorporated in the Body of Christ, the Church. This formation is for the unbaptized, those baptized in other Christian communities, and Catholics who have not received all three Sacraments of Initiation (Baptism, Confirmation and Eucharist).

**Penance:** The Sacrament of Penance is celebrated every Saturday from 3:00 p.m. until 4:00 p.m., during a Communal Penance Service during Advent and Lent *or by appointment*.

419-244-6711 or speak to one of the Deacons of the Parish. **Religious Life:** Consecrated women and men religious by their lives witness the joy of eternal union with God. Freed from earthly cares, they more fully manifest the Kingdom of God to all Christians. The structure of the vowed life frees consecrated religious to live entirely for God and others. **Matrimony:** Anyone planning to be married must contact the Parish at least six months in advance. The exact date and time of your wedding should not be determined until after consultation with a Priest or Deacon. If either party has previously been civilly or religiously married, the Presider is not permitted to set a date for the wedding without resolving the previous marriage.

**Pastoral Care of the Sick**: When a parishioner is confined to home because of age or infirmity, please call the Parish Office to arrange for Holy Communion at home. When a parishioner is in a hospital or nursing home, please call the Parish Office to arrange for a visit. You may wish to call before any planned surgeries. When one is seriously ill, the healing Presence of the Lord should be requested in the Sacrament of the Sick by calling the Parish Office at 419-885-5791. Please call, do not email in urgent situations.

A Note About the Notes: There are several liturgical guidelines that we use to choose and place the music throughout the Mass. According to the General Instruction of the Roman Missal, the Communion Antiphon's purpose "is to express the communicants' union in spirit by means of the unity of their voices, to show joy of heart, and to highlight more clearly the 'communitarian' nature of the procession to receive Communion," (GIRM, 86). The Church has chosen the Scripture readings and, in place of song, an antiphon for Entrance, and Communion. The antiphons prescribed for each day are usually taken from the

Psalms, so while it might seem strange to us, a psalm is very appropriate to be sung during communion. Paul Inwood wrote a very beautiful and devotional refrain to his setting of Psalm 16: "O Lord, you are the center of my life: I will always praise you, I will always serve you, I will always keep you in my sight." This poetic refrain is insightful when thinking about the Eucharist.

<u>Impromptu Choir--</u>We invite all people to join the choir for a Sunday or two throughout the summer. We will practice 20 minutes before the 10 a.m. and 12 p.m. Masses, going through all the music you may need to know that day and then you will sing for Mass in the choir. Families or individuals are welcome to give the Impromptu Choir a try any time between now and August 31.


### Save the Date: Jaguar Jump Dav





Every year, the Diocese dutifully submits the necessary documentation required by the USCCB for a diocese to be in compliance. Every three years, an onsite audit is conducted, when not only all necessary documentation is dutifully submitted, but in addition, Pastoral Center,

parish and diocesan school employees are interviewed concerning practices and protocols related to creating and maintaining a safe environment for our children and youth.

The last 3-year audit was conducted in September 2024 and all audited Articles within the Charter were found to be compliant. The next onsite audit will be conducted in 2027.

The Diocese of Toledo remains committed to ensuring the protection of children and providing a safe environment for all young people. 
