



RECONCILIATION: *English*: Saturdays, 3:00 PM - 3:30 PM, at St. James Lower Church or by appointment.






Thank you to those who have already responded generously to Archbishop Richard Henning's invitation to contribute to the 2025 Catholic Appeal.

Just a friendly reminder that all employees and volunteers of the Parish must complete a Criminal Offender Record Information (CORI) Acknowledgement Form annually. Annual submission time for St. Gabriel Parish is September. In addition, all employees must complete Protecting God's Children and all volunteers who have any contact with children must also complete Protecting God's Children. The training is an in-person, 3 hour training that is scheduled at various locations throughout the Archdiocese on a regular basis. If you have already attended the PGC training in the past, you have met the requirement of the Archdiocese. Fr. Le recently misspoke at Mass when he said that you had to retake the training. Version 4.0 of the training was released in 2022, however, there is no mandate at this time from the Archdiocese that the training needs to be retaken. 
