RECONCILIATION: *English*: Saturdays, 3:00 PM - 3:30 PM, at St. James Lower Church or by appointment.





The training is an in-person, 3 hour training that is scheduled at various locations throughout the Archdiocese on a regular basis. Version 4.0 of the training was released in 2022, however, there is no mandate at this time from the Archdiocese that the training needs to be retaken.
