RECONCILIATION: *English:* Saturdays, 3:00 PM - 3:30 PM, at St. James Lower Church or by appointment.



Exaltation of the Holy Cross

- 1 Saint Helena, in the 4th century, found the Holy Cross in Jerusalem.
- 2 In the year 614, the Persians took it as a war trophy.
- 3 Emperor Heraclius recovered it and brought it back to Jerusalem on September 14, 628.
- 4 The wood was divided into parts, sending fragments to Rome, Constantinople, and Jerusalem.
- 5 Splinters were distributed to churches all over the world, known as the "relics of the True Cross."




