

English - 4th Sunday at 1:00 PM, on the following months: January, March, May, July, September, and November. Spanish - 3rd Sunday of every month at the 11:30 AM Spanish Mass.

BAPTISMS AT ST. JOHN THE BAPTIST CHURCH

English - 2nd Sunday at 10:00 AM Mass on the following January, March, May, July, September, and November.

Brazilian - 4th Sunday of every month after the 11:45 AM Brazilian Mass.

2026 BAPTISMAL INSTRUCTION: Both Parents and Godparents must attend. *English*: 1st Sunday of the month on the following months: March, June, September, and December at 1:00 PM, at St. James, lower church.

Spanish: 1st Saturday of every month at 1:00 PM, at St. James, lower church.

Brazilian: 1/3, 3/7, 5/2, 7/11, 9/5, 11/7 from 3:30 PM- 5:00 PM at St. John the Baptist, lower church. Parents are asked to preregister at the Parish Office/Rectory one month before baptism instruction takes place. Please bring the child's birth certificate and a Confirmation certificate for at least one of the Godparents.

MARRIAGE: Arrangement with a priest of the Parish at least six months prior to the wedding.

RECONCILIATION: *English*: Saturdays, 3:00 PM - 3:30 PM, at St. James Lower Church or by appointment.
