


MARRIAGE: Arrangement with a priest of the Parish at least six months prior to the wedding date.

SOME GREAT THINGS YOU CAN DO FOR THIS LENT

Ash Wednesday marks the beginning of the season of Lent, a sacred 40-day journey that prepares us for the celebration of Easter. During this time, we are invited to deepen and renew our spiritual lives through the traditional practices of prayer, fasting, and almsgiving. Below are some meaningful ways to live out this Lenten call and nurture your relationship with God:

1. Observe the Church’s practices of fasting and abstinence. Catholics aged 14 and older are required to abstain from meat on Ash Wednesday and on all Fridays of Lent. Catholics between the ages of 18 and 59 are also required to fast on Ash Wednesday and Good Friday. On days of fasting, only one full meal is permitted, along with two smaller meatless meals sufficient to maintain strength. Eating between meals is not allowed, though liquids such as water, milk, and fruit juices are permitted.
2. Prepare for Mass by reading the Sunday Scriptures ahead of time. Making this a weekly habit can help you listen more deeply and engage more fully during the liturgy.
3. Try a new spiritual practice. Consider signing up for an hour of Eucharistic Adoration or making a renewed commitment to participate more intentionally in Mass at our parish.
4. Practice simplicity and generosity. Be mindful of unnecessary spending, and consider donating the money you save to a local charity or someone in need.
5. Use daily spiritual reflections. Keep a Lenten reflection book by your bedside and spend a few moments each day in quiet prayer. Many parishes offer these resources for free or at a low cost, and several excellent options are available online.
6. Fast from unkind or insensitive speech. Commit to avoiding gossip, cruel comments, and uncharitable conversations—including getting lost in negative social media spaces.
7. Build community by getting to know your neighbors. Introduce yourself, invite someone to share a meal, or bring food to an elderly or homebound neighbor.
8. Celebrate the Sacrament of Reconciliation. If it has been a long time, simply tell the priest and ask for guidance. This sacrament is a powerful opportunity for healing, mercy, and renewal.

May this Lenten season be a time of grace, growth, and deeper conversion for us all.

ALGUNAS COSAS ESTUPENDAS QUE PUEDES HACER DURANTE ESTA CUARESMA

El Miércoles de Ceniza marca el comienzo de la Cuaresma, un camino sagrado de 40 días que nos prepara para la celebración de la Pascua. Durante este tiempo, se nos invita a profundizar y renovar nuestra vida espiritual a través de las prácticas tradicionales de la oración, el ayuno y la limosna. A continuación, se presentan algunas maneras significativas de vivir este llamado cuaresmal y nutrir nuestra relación con Dios:

1. Observa las prácticas de ayuno y abstinencia de la Iglesia. Los católicos mayores de 14 años deben abstenerse de comer carne el Miércoles de Ceniza y todos los viernes de Cuaresma. Los católicos entre 18 y 59 años también deben ayunar el Miércoles de Ceniza y el Viernes Santo. En los días de ayuno, solo se permite una comida completa, junto con dos comidas más pequeñas sin carne, suficientes para mantener las fuerzas. No se permite comer entre comidas, aunque sí se permiten líquidos como agua, leche y jugos de frutas.
2. Prepárate para la Misa leyendo las lecturas dominicales con anticipación. Convertir esto en un hábito semanal te ayudará a escuchar con mayor atención y a participar más plenamente en la liturgia.
3. Prueba una nueva práctica espiritual. Considera inscribirte para una hora de Adoración Eucarística o comprométete a participar de manera más consciente en la Misa en nuestra parroquia.
4. Practica la sencillez y la generosidad. Sé consciente de los gastos innecesarios y considera donar el dinero que ahorres a una organización benéfica local o a alguien que lo necesite.
5. Dedicar tiempo a la reflexión espiritual diaria. Ten un libro de reflexiones de Cuaresma junto a tu cama y dedica unos momentos cada día a la oración silenciosa. Muchas parroquias ofrecen estos recursos de forma gratuita o a bajo costo, y hay varias opciones excelentes disponibles en línea.
6. Abstente de hablar con dureza o insensibilidad. Comprométete a evitar los chismes, los comentarios crueles y las conversaciones poco caritativas, incluyendo el uso excesivo de las redes sociales de forma negativa.
7. Construyan comunidad conociendo a sus vecinos. Preséntense, inviten a alguien a compartir una comida o lleven comida a un vecino anciano o que no pueda salir de casa.
8. Celebren el Sacramento de la Reconciliación. Si hace mucho tiempo que no se confiesan, simplemente díganle al sacerdote y pídanle orientación. Este sacramento es una poderosa oportunidad para la sanación, la misericordia y la renovación.

Que esta Cuaresma sea un tiempo de gracia, crecimiento y profunda conversión para todos nosotros.
