- Salad Dressing

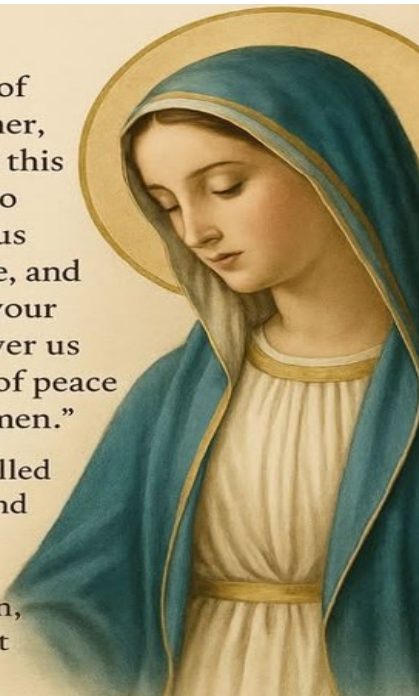

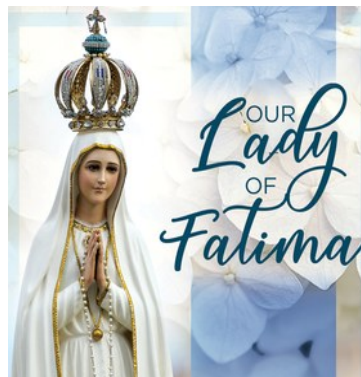

- 1** On the crucifix, make the Sign of the Cross, then say the Apostles Creed.
- 2** Then on the first large bead, and the three smaller beads that follow, say one Our Father, three Hail Marys and one Glory Be for an increase in the virtues of faith, hope, and love.
- 3** On the first decade, announce the First Mystery and pause for few seconds to briefly contemplate on it. Say one Our Father, ten Hail Marys, one Glory Be, and the Fatima Prayer (O, my Jesus)
- 4** Repeat this in the second, third, fourth, and fifth decades.
- 5** Say the Hail, Holy Queen, followed by the Rosary Prayer.
- 6** Recite the Litany of the Blessed Virgin Mary.

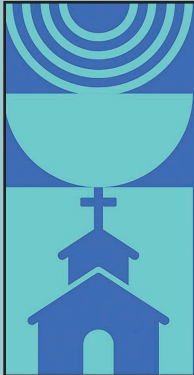

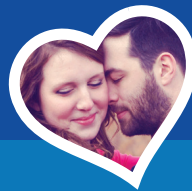
