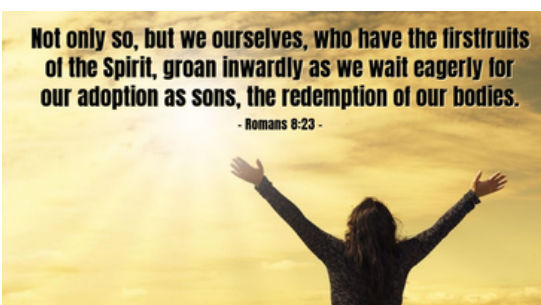

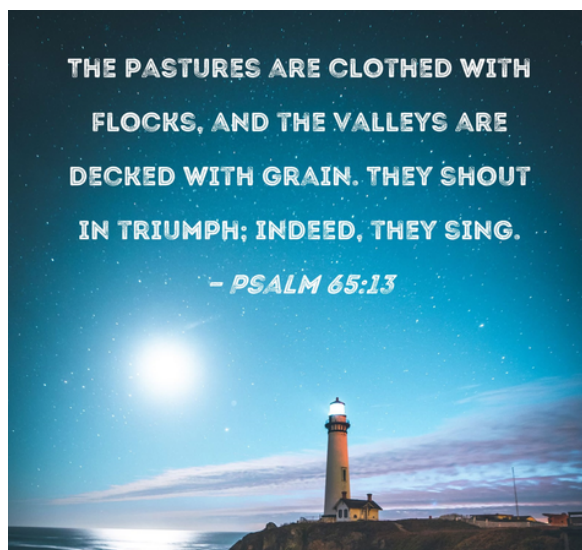

SACRAMENT OF BAPTISM †

To schedule a Baptism date, please bring the completed Baptism Registration Form, available on our website or at the parish office, the child's birth certificate, and Confirmation certificate(s) for both or at least one of the Godparents. Parents are asked to pre-register at the parish office at least one month before the Baptism instruction class takes place.

Bautismo en español:

Instrucción prebautismal: El primer sábado de cada mes a la 1:00 p. m. en la iglesia inferior, obligatoria para padres y padrinos. La inscripción debe realizarse con un mes de anticipación en la Rectoría, presentando el certificado de nacimiento y el certificado de Confirmación de al menos uno de los padrinos.

Bautismo en español: El tercer domingo de cada mes durante la Misa de las 11:30 AM

Bodas: Favor de consultar con el sacerdote o diácono con al menos 6 meses de anticipación.

Confesiones: Sábados de 3:00 PM a 3:30 PM en la iglesia de San Santiago, en la iglesia inferior, o llame a la Rectoría para programar una cita.

Sacramento de los Enfermos: Si tienes un miembro de familia o amigo que no pueda asistir a la Iglesia por edad o enfermedad, por favor llamar a la oficina para que se le provee de visitas con la administración de los sacramentos.



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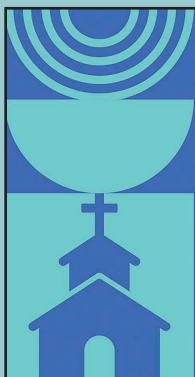


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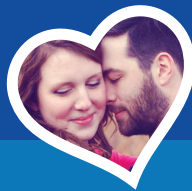


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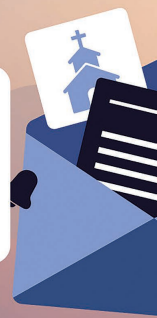
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
