

The following information was announced in the homily last weekend,

There is no easy way to reveal that my pastoral assignments at St. Francis Xavier Cathedral and St. John the Evangelist Parish will be concluding as of June 30, 2024, after 5 years as pastor. On July 1, 2024, I will begin a new assignment as Pastor of St. James in Cooperstown and St. Joseph in Kellnersville. In my new assignment, I will still be a pastor, but the parishes will be more pastorally manageable as I continue to serve as the Judicial Vicar for the diocese. The Reverend Ryan Krueger, (pronounced Kroo-ger) currently the Pastor of Corpus Christi Parish in Sturgeon Bay, will become the new Rector and Pastor of St. Francis Xavier Cathedral and Pastor of St. John the Evangelist Parish effective on July 1. I know you will welcome Fr. Krueger in the same spirit as you welcomed me 5 years ago.

I have been blessed as your pastor at St. Francis Xavier Cathedral and St. John the Evangelist Parish since July 1, 2019. I remember when I came to the Cathedral for my priestly ordination in 2005 and gazed into the sanctuary toward the altar and, mused by its beauty, thought to myself, "I don't think I'll ever be assigned here." Moreover, St. John's was a community I scarcely knew existed, and now have since been privileged and honored to have followed in the long line of succession of pastors and priests that began with the Venerable Samuel Mazzuchelli, even before the formal foundation of the Diocese of Green Bay.

My impending departure is bittersweet. I have wholeheartedly enjoyed my time here. I have also formed many friendships that I know will continue. Out of all my assignments over the years, I have felt most at home here. I do not believe that I was ever so much accepted and embraced by parish communities, and so quickly, as I have been over the past five years at both parishes. Whereas both parishes have their unique characters and differences, I have nothing but good and positive memories that I take with me.

This change is positive, and one that I wholeheartedly support for the good of the parishes, the tribunal and diocesan ministry, and my overall well-being. It will allow for a new pastor, with a fresh set of eyes, to engage these parishes in order that they can be fully engaged and alive. Both parishes have much potential to thrive, but need more care and attention than what I can reasonably provide, given my responsibilities to three unique assignments, each with their own unique characters, blessings, and challenges. The change will also allow for me to engage my canonical expertise more deeply and assist the bishop and diocesan curia in other canonical matters that need attention.

I am thankful to Bishop Ricken for his unwavering support through the past five years and beyond. We have worked well together and will continue to do so. He has been a source of encouragement to me since he was installed as our Bishop. I thank him for the support and confidence he has shown in me and for his example of holiness with which he leads.

May God bless you. I will miss you, but not forget you. You are in my heart and prayers. Please continue to pray for me as I will for you.

The donation for these sacraments and services has remained the same for over thirty years throughout the Dioceses of Wisconsin. Recently, when the Bishops of the State of Wisconsin gathered, they decreed that stipends should be adjusted to reflect the current time. The new stipend is as follows:

Mass Stipend	\$20
Funeral Stole Fee	\$75
Wedding & Quinceanera Stole Fee	\$100

This new fee structure will become effective July 1st, 2024. It will **not** be applied retroactively to those who have already paid the appropriate amount from the former fee scale. The new fee structure will be applied to all new requests received as of July 1st, 2024. As always, if someone is not able to offer the stipend, the parish is always happy to provide the sacrament or service with no fee. Please know, too, that any stipend money collected goes to the parish in support of its ministry and services provided to the parish community; it does not go personally to the priest.
