V2	Three Onions from sets	
V3	Four tomatoes	
V4	Three Courgettes not exceeding 6" long	
V5	Six Runner Beans	
V6	Root Vegetables, three of any one variety	
V7	Three of any other Vegetable not listed above	
V8	Top Fruit, three of any one Variety	
V9	Soft Fruit, six of any one Variety	
V10	Chillies, three of any one Variety	
V11	A jam jar of six culinary Herbs, all different	

FLOWER CLASSES

F1	Display of mixed cut Flowers and Foliage	
F2	A hand-tied posy	
F3	A vase of five flowers, any one Variety	
F4	A vase of three Dahlias, mixed or single Varieties	
F5	A vase of three roses, mixed or single Varieties	
F6	One perfect flower or stem of flowers

RULES and PROCEDURES

Please read carefully as the rules differ from previous Shows

1. The Judges' decision is final.
2. **Access to the Hall will follow the current guidelines for Covid safety.**
3. **Covid secure Produce judging – see below:**
4. All entries must be grown or produced by the exhibitor. No more than three entries per class per member/garden, other than at the Show Secretary's discretion. No entry can have been previously exhibited in this Show.
5. **Exhibits will only be accepted between 9 a.m. and 12 noon on the day of the Show. PLEASE ALLOW TIME FOR QUEUING FOR SOCIAL DISTANCING.** Staging to be completed by 12.15 p.m.
6. No exhibit will be accepted without a correctly completed entry form. It is the exhibitor's responsibility to complete show cards.
7. Exhibitors will be responsible for staging their entries. Flower vases are available.
8. No exhibit to be removed from the show area before the presentation of prizes.
9. All exhibits to be removed by 6 pm on the day of the show.
10. No member of the public will be allowed into the Hall before the official opening time.
11. The Oare & District Village Hall Committee accept no responsibility for loss or damage to any exhibit.
12. The organisers reserve the right to change the venue or times of the Show or to cancel at their discretion.
13. Entrants are assumed to have read and accepted these rules.
14. Trophies to be held for one year and returned cleaned to the Show Secretary for the following year's Show.

CUPS WILL BE AWARDED AT THE SHOW SECRETARIES' DISCRETION

PRODUCE CLASSES – COVID SECURE PROCEDURES

- There will be one produce judge only and no other person will be permitted near the entries during judging.
- **All entries must be submitted with one element (a slice of cake, one biscuit, one roll, etc.) on a separate small plate.** Both plates to be covered securely with clingfilm.
- The judge will taste the single item or slice which will then be thrown away. The remainder of the entry will remain untouched and can be taken away by the owner at the end of the show.
