Section 1- Team Placements

Every season at SEO we begin with registration. No cheerleading experience is required to join SEO.

Informational Meeting: June 29th, 3PM @ SEO

Packet Submission Window: June 30th - July 13th

New Athlete Uniform Fee: \$250 (\$125 due on July 15th and August 15th)

Athletes are responsible for the uniform fee & tuition in a timely manner. Payments can be paid by cash, credit card, or check. (Credit card payments will be subject to an additional 3% fee, and you will be charged \$20 if your check bounces.) If you need a different payment date due to paydays, etc...you must note that on your payment schedule attachment.

Regular season fees include the following:

- Competition fees Practice T-shirt and Tank Top
- 1 competition hair item Coaches' pay
- Routine music fees
- *Optional items to be purchased through a separate link:

Shoes, backpack, sports bra and spandex

We have included everything your athlete will need for the regular season in your fees for the season. *No hidden costs, no surprises.*

Team practices:

First team practice is July 13th. Athletes must have a handbook turned in to participate. One and a half hours total team practices per week (all included in tuition). There is a possibility of additional summer practice hours. Sundays 3:00-4:30PM are the scheduled practice days.

Section 2 - Communication

Our coaching staff is happy to talk with you or your athlete about any concerns that you have. Please understand that due to having so many athletes, teams, and classes here at SEO, staff members are often very busy and may not have time to chat in-between practices. We do ask that for topics pertaining to joining Stars, practices, competitions, events, apparel orders, teams, etc. email us at: sonicelitestars@gmail.com

In the event you would like to have a face-to-face meeting with an SEO staff member before or after a practice, you must make a request via the email above and confirm an appointment at least 24 hours in advance. We ask that this is done so we can plan enough time to adequately address any concerns you have and ensure that your needs are met.

Unless it is an **emergency**, please refrain from texting, Facebook messaging, or instant messaging our staff. If it is an **emergency**, please use any means necessary to contact the staff member you need directly.

Section 3 - Attendance Expectations/Other Information

Throughout the season attendance is incredibly important! If just ONE person is missing during a practice other athletes are affected. Poor attendance stunts the development of other athletes and the overall momentum of the team. Because of this we require near perfect attendance. We want to give every athlete the opportunity to progress as far as they possibly can in the sport of cheerleading.

Tardies:

While we understand things can happen that might make athletes late to practices, it is important for everyone to understand that athletes being late will affect a practice. Please reach out if your athlete is not going to attend practice, or is going to be late. Being late to practice multiple times over 15 minutes without notice will result in an absence.

Competitions:

Attendance at all competitions is **MANDATORY**. If an athlete is a "no-show" at a competition, there will be a \$50 fee charged that must be paid before they can continue to practice or compete. In order to not receive this charge, we must be notified no later than 48 hours before a competition that athletes will not be present. The only reason to miss a competition is for sickness or an emergency.

Practices:

Always make sure to be well hydrated and have recently eaten before coming to practice or a class. If an athlete is going to miss practice then please email us and let us know in advance.

Athletes are REQUIRED to remove ALL jewelry, have their hair up tightly and out of their face, and their fingernail length will be no longer than the end of their fingertips. These are all safety measures we are taking for our athletes and we take this seriously. If an athlete comes to practice and is not adhering to this requirement, their parent will be emailed, the athlete will sit out of practice until it is corrected and parents will be charged a \$25 inconvenience fee for each practice that is happens.

The practice atmosphere is all business (mostly...we have fun too!) so come ready to work, push yourself, learn, and progress your skills. A good attitude is expected from all athletes inside of the gym at all times. SEO is a "drama free" zone... Please leave it at the door. The gym is our athlete's sanctuary. We are practicing for competitions. Give each practice your absolute best effort at all times. Your coaches have high expectations and will accept *nothing less*. We want to help athletes become the best that they can possibly be and we need your best effort to achieve that together.

USASF Registration:

All SEO athletes must be current and registered in the USASF system no later than <u>01 Oct</u> <u>2025</u> or parents will be charged a \$50 penalty fee each month until it is completed. This is something that is required and non-negotiable. You will need to go to <u>www.usasfmembers.net</u> and create an account, register your athlete and pay their membership fee. Remember that athletes 18 or older need to do the USASF safety training as well. Please know that military/school ID will not work to verify age. If you need assistance, please email us and let us know. We are happy to assist!

DSHS/DDA:

SEO will be accepting DSHS/DDA payments. The account needs to be set up with SEO at the time of registration. Please have your athletes representative reach out to us right away so we can get it set up immediately. Families will be responsible for tuition/uniform payment until first payment is approved through DSHS.

SEO Name and Logo Usage:

At no time is anyone authorized to use any of the Sonic Elite Olympia logos or team names. Our name/team names may be requested to create clothing or articles for athletes or parents for special events/competitions, but only with prior permission of the gym. We have the right to approve or deny any request for any reason. Just email us with an explanation of what you are creating with details, to request permission. Our logo or name may never be used for any kind of fundraising. At no time can anything be sold to anyone with our name, logo or teams names on it.

Sonic Culture:

Here at SEO we are trying to create a culture of inclusion, heart and family. Every athlete and parent is responsible for their own actions and will be held accountable for anything that does not meet our standard of respect towards our gym, the local community and the cheer community. We will treat all other gyms and their athletes with the same respect we would our own and will listen to the guidance of all competition event staff and judges. Remember a positive attitude goes a long way and that we should all treat each other the way we would like to be treated. Be the elite example of kindness and show everyone what the #sonicculture truly is.
