Adel Good Samaritan Food Pantry (GSFP) expands their hours.

- **Expanded pantry hours.** Food pantry is now open the 3rd Saturday of the month from Noon to 2 p.m. in addition to their regular hours (Mon & Tues 12 pm- 2 pm; 4th Monday of each month 5 pm -6 pm).
- **Eligibility:** Residents of ADM schools, Van Meter Schools, and anyone with a Redfield, Dexter, or Linden address are eligible.
- **Summer Kid Food Packs:** Free summer food is available for kids grades K-12th grade in Adel, DeSoto, Minburn, Van Meter, Linden, Dexter, and Redfield who need food. Each bag has 7 breakfast and 7 lunch items as well as 14 snack items. Pick up at the Food Pantry during store hours (above) or Tues nights at the Adel Farmer's Market (at the Adel Fair Grounds) from 4-7 p.m.
