The Grief Ministry

Caring Hearts Bereavement Team

The grief ministry, known as St John's Caring Hearts Bereavement Team, is a subcommittee of Works of Mercy. The focus of this ministry is to provide a variety of grief materials and opportunities to those grieving the loss of a loved one.

Special grief events with guest speakers are scheduled throughout the year. Last Fall this ministry facilitated a six-session Grief Support group that met over a three-month period. The event was open to the public and the Caring Hearts team members provided a light meal. The ministry is looking forward to hosting a Grief Support group again this Fall. The team also maintains a group of grief books in St John's parish library. In November, this ministry assists at the All Souls Day Mass with the candle ceremony. The candle ceremony remembers those who have died during the past year.

The ongoing focus of this ministry is to reach out to parishioners who have experienced a recent loss. *Journeying through Grief* is a four-book series that is sent out at intervals over a year by one of the Caring Hearts Bereavement team members. Each book describes the issues and feelings people tend to encounter at various times during the first year following a loss. This ministry does not meet on a regular basis. Most communication between team members is done via email.
