ONE PARISH, ONE BOOK

As we begin reading The Seven Pillars of Catholic Spirituality, which was gifted to each family, consider using the Notes section in the back of your book to record your thoughts and reflections. Through our shared reading, we will explore seven essential aspects of our Catholic faith: Confession, Daily Prayer, the Mass, the Bible, Fasting, Spiritual Reading, and the Rosary. These pillars can become the foundation of your spiritual life if you allow them to do so. As you read, ponder and discuss, remain open to God's promptings in your heart. Extra books are in the entryway.

Questions to Consider:

- What do you most appreciate about being Catholic?
- On a scale of 1-10, how would you rate your spiritual health right now?
- How might God be inviting you to grow spiritually at this time?
- What do you hope to gain from this experience?

Seven Pillars Challenge:

The saints lived the Seven Pillars and used them to grow in holiness. Choose a patron saint to accompany you on this journey. Learn about this saint's life and ask for his or her intercession as you open your heart to God through this book.

PREPARING FOR LENT

Lent is fast approaching. On February 4th, many parishioners and their families attended a FIRE-UP Your Faith & Fellowship presentation on the "Season of Lent" by Ed Anderson. Topics covered included the Three Pillars of Lent (prayer, fasting, and almsgiving), ways to grow deeper in our relationship with God during Lent, and some Catholic doctrines related to this season. Parishioners participated in a prayer, meal, and discussion during the evening. Child care was provided. This is the 3rd program in a series of five. Everyone is welcome to future gatherings!
