SAINT THERESE RELICS

The first-class St. Therese relics will be on display for veneration at the Basilica and National Shrine of Mary Help of Christians at Holy Hill in Wisconsin. This will be one of only 40 sites nationwide displaying the relics, and it is the closest site to lowa. The relics arrived in the United States from Lisieux, France in commemoration of the 100th anniversary of her canonization. At Holy Hill, the relics will be on display for veneration from Saturday afternoon through early Tuesday morning, Nov. 15-18.

ADVENT PRESENTATION

All St John's parishioners are invited and encouraged to attend our first Wednesday evening Adult Faith Formation session on Dec 3 from 5:30 - 6:30 pm in the Parish Hall.

We will be providing a seasonal opportunity for faith, fellowship, and food! Our discussion topics are Advent and Eucharistic Adoration. Advent comes from the Latin adventus, meaning "arrival". We'll discuss some of the history, why's, and how's of this beautiful 4-week season of preparation for the arrival of Christ. Eucharist Adoration is a deeply spiritual and meaningful Catholic tradition to spend guiet, prayerful, and contemplative time with Christ outside of Holy Mass. We confidently believe that Jesus is present fully: body, blood, soul, and divinity in the Sacred Eucharist. When the consecrated Host is placed in a monstrance and displayed on the altar, we can prayerfully adore and be in Christ's presence. We bring our prayers of thanksgiving, intercession, petition, contrition, and glory to God in Adoration. He loves us and He wants to spend time with us. We'll share some history, meaning, and opportunities for receiving God's gifts and growing in our faith and our relationship with the Lord during Eucharistic Adoration times offered in our parish.
