Step 3: Watch your email closely during the bidding process as you will be notified if out bid and it will ask you if you would like to place a higher bid.

Step 4: The online silent auction will close at 7:15p on Saturday, November 8th. If you are the winning bidder, you will be notified once the auction ends and will be given instructions at that time how to pay and pick up your item(s).

All items must be paid for within 48 hours either in person or online.
