C.H. Berres Mosel, Germany

From Germany's famed Mosel region comes C.H. Berres, a historic estate where the Berres family has cultivated vineyards since 1510. Now led by 21st-generation winemaker Markus Berres, this Mittelmosel property blends deeply rooted traditions with a fresh, modern perspective, focusing on the purity and precision that make Mosel wines so celebrated.

After studying at Geisenheim and gaining international experience, Markus ushered the winery into a new era, revitalizing old vineyards and crafting vibrant, contemporary Rieslings. Many of their vines are old and ungrafted, planted in iconic sites, including Ürzig's Würzgarten. The result is a wine that beautifully balances heritage & innovation, delivering clarity, character & charm.

Hilary's Note: "I know Riesling isn't always the first bottle people reach for, but a beautifully made Riesling can completely change that perception. After one taste, I knew this was a wine worth sharing with you. Thoughtfully crafted and layered with depth, it's the kind of bottle that invites you to rethink everything you knew about Riesling - elegant, expressive, and truly memorable."

Owen Roe Yakima, Washington

Founded in 1999 by the O'Reilly family, Owen Roe built its reputation on sourcing exceptional fruit from Oregon's Willamette Valley and Washington's Yakima Valley. Their philosophy has been clear: great wine begins with the vineyard. Today, the winery partners with carefully chosen sites, working closely with growers through harvest to ensure quality and true site expression.

Co-founders David and Angelica O'Reilly share a deep passion for fine wine, first shaped by cool-climate Pinot Noir and later rooted firmly in Oregon. Over more than three decades, they've crafted a diverse, critically recognized portfolio defined by balance, structure, and a sense of place, all while building a lasting family legacy that their eight children have helped shape and grow.

Hilary's Note: "This Grenache immediately caught my attention with its vibrant red fruit aromas and beautifully textured palate. I've always loved how Grenache can be fruity, earthy, smoky, and just a little savory all at once, striking a seamless balance. It's the kind of wine that's effortless to enjoy and easy to share - though you may find yourself wanting to keep this one all to yourself."

Berres Estate Riesling

This 100% Estate Riesling is a striking expression of the Mosel, grown on steep, multicolored slate slopes with vines, some over 90 years old, deeply rooted in this storied landscape. Hand harvested & crafted with care, it opens with a floral nose layered with white peach, nectarine, and white blossoms, offering both richness & precision.



On the palate, the wine is beautifully balanced, with vibrant acidity & pronounced minerality giving shape to its clear, focused fruit. Riesling's hallmark acidity provides lift and energy, bringing freshness and finesse to every sip. The result is a wine with depth, vibrancy, and character.

Perfect Pairings: Riesling's vibrant acidity & subtle touch of sweetness make it a natural partner for dishes with a little heat & aromatic flair. Try it with Thai green curry, spicy shrimp or chicken stir-fry, or classic pork schnitzel. Bright, expressive, & food-friendly, this wine comes alive at the table.



Sinister Hand

This Grenache-driven blend brings together Grenache, Tannat, Mourvèdre, and Syrah to create a wine that's vibrant, expressive, and easy to love. Aromas of blueberry, raspberry, strawberry, and rose petals lift from the glass, offering a bright and inviting introduction to this beautifully balanced red wine.



On the palate, this wine is layered, with lively acidity giving lift to its dark, savory fruit. Juicy raspberry and black cherry are framed by hints of vanilla and toasty French oak, while chewy tannins add structure and depth. The result is a wine with richness, energy, and character.

Perfect Pairings: This red shines with grilled lamb chops, BBQ ribs, or herb-crusted roast chicken. Want something more comforting? It's just as delicious with Trevor's Combo pizza or a juicy burger. Savory & satisfying, this is the kind of red that makes any meal feel like an occasion.
