Yolo Employment Services is the largest employer of people with intellectual and other developmental disabilities in Yolo County and have been a valuable employee since 1968. With over 70 people on our payroll, we are one of the largest non-profits in Yolo County.



Yolo Employment Services serve people with the most severe disabilities in our community. We support them as they become independent, self-supporting, and participating citizens.

Our Services Enrich the Community in Many Ways:

- In addition to hiring people with disabilities to work at Yolo Employment Services, we supported over 120 people with disabilities working in more than 30 companies throughout Yolo, Solano, and Sacramento County.
- The taxable dollars our workers earn reduce SSI benefits they receive from the government.
- The cost of serving a person in our programs (\$12,000 a year) is a small fraction of cost of care in a state-run facility (\$1,000,000). Our programs are an example of your tax dollars at work in a very cost-effective and productive manner.
- With our support, people with significant disabilities are working in their community.
- With our support, people who have significant disabilities are taking their places as contributing members of their communities.
