METHOD OF PAYMENT

Unless other arrangements have been made, payment for goods and services is expected prior to the services rendered. Cash, check, cashier's check and credit card are all acceptable forms of payment.

Rose City Cemetery has been serving families in Portland and the Metro area for over 100 years. We are a family owned and operated business. This Cemetery is an Endowment Care Cemetery and is licensed and regulated by the Oregon State Mortuary and Cemetery Board, (971) 673-1500. It is our hope to serve you with great respect and honor during this difficult time. Please ask your funeral director to explain our Funeral Arrangement Packages, in order to provide you with the most appropriate package for your family's needs.

The goods and services shown below are those we can provide to our customers. You may choose only the items you desire. However, any funeral arrangements you select will include a charge for our basic services and for the transfer of the deceased to the funeral home. If legal or other requirements mean you must buy any item you did not ask for, we will explain the reason in writing on the statement we provide describing the goods and services you selected.

This list does not include prices for any items that you ask us to purchase, such as cemetery or crematory services, flowers and newspaper notices. The prices for those items will be shown on your bill, or the statement describing the funeral goods and services.

Our basic service charge includes, but is not limited to, staff to respond to initial request for service; arrangement conference with family or responsible party; preparation and filing of necessary certificates and permits; placement of obituary notices; planning of funeral arrangements; and coordination of service with cemetery, crematory, vault companies and others as required. Also included in this charge are the overhead expenses relative to our facility such as insurance, maintenance, utility expenses, administrative costs, use of equipment, and inventory expenses. The fee for our basic services, and the cost of transferring the deceased to the funeral home will be added to the total cost of the funeral arrangements you select. (These fees are already included in our charges for direct cremation/aquamation, immediate burials, and forwarding or receiving remains.)

Except in certain special cases, embalming is not required by law. Embalming may be necessary, however, if you select certain funeral arrangements, such as a funeral with viewing, or a crypt placement. If you do not want embalming, you usually have the right to choose an arrangement that does not require you to pay for it, such as direct cremation or immediate burial. A formaldehyde-free embalming procedure, "Ecobalming," is now available upon request.

TRANSFER OF DECEASED TO FUNERAL HOME......\$450

This service includes a vehicle, personnel and equipment. The local service area is 25 miles. An additional charge of \$4.25 per mile (one way only) will be charged if outside the local service area.





The charge for direct cremation or aquamation includes the transfer of remains to Rose City, local transportation to crematory, necessary authorizations, refrigeration of the remains, cremation or aquamation fee, and basic services of the staff. This charge does not include the use of facilities and staff for any visitation or ceremony, public or private, prior to the cremation. If you want to arrange a direct cremation, you can use an alternative container. Alternative containers encase the body and can be made of materials like fiberboard or composition material (with or without an outside covering). The container we provide is a cardboard base with a cardboard top. You may also select any casket from our funeral home.
