What can you do during National Only Citizens Vote Week?

SHINE THE LIGHT ON NONCITIZEN VOTING!

Call to Action: Shine the light on noncitizen voting!

- Speak to your neighbors and show them information from www.onlycitizensvotecoalition.com
- Write letters to the editor to your local newspaper
- Call in to talk radio and call for local officials to address the issue of noncitizen voting
- Host public sign rallies to bring attention to this issue (Tent festivals, Main Streets, local fairs and events in your area – TAKE PICTURES and send them to megan@onlycitizensvotecoalition.com to publish in the weekly OCVC Newsletter!

Ask Local officials to Celebrate Constitution and Citizenship Day!

September 17th is Constitution and Citizenship Day – a commemoration of the 1787 final passage of the U.S. Constitution by the Constitutional Convention in Philadelphia.

Call to Action: County commissioners / supervisors, local election boards and officials, other local officials

- Attend public meetings of local bodies, ask to make public comments regarding noncitizen voting, and ask what that public body is doing to ensure that only citizens are registered /voting
- Organize concerned citizens to meet with your public officials: local officials, state legislators, managers at the local driver's license agencies
 - Ask what the process is to ensure that noncitizens are NOT being registered to vote in your area and how citizenship is confirmed prior to being registered
 - Provide the local agencies with copies of the America First Legal Foundation letter, that explains how any local agency can request confirmation of citizenship status of registered voters – and the Dept of Homeland Security is required by federal law to provide the information
 - Ask what databases they are utilizing to confirm citizenship status of voters on the rolls

What can you do during National Only Citizens Vote Week?

SHINE THE LIGHT ON NONCITIZEN VOTING!

Call to Action: Congress. Federal Action Day – Support the SAVE Act!

- Contact your Members of Congress asking for their support for passage of the SAVE Act (a bill that will close loopholes in federal law by requiring documentary proof of citizenship to register to vote)

Call to Action: State legislators. Take state actions to protect citizen voters and block noncitizens from voting

- Contact state legislators to ensure that your state constitution adequately protects against noncitizen voting and, if not, to introduce the Only Citizens Vote state constitutional amendment
- Ask what they are doing to ensure that the registered voter list in your state is compared to the citizenship data at the DMV – to remove noncitizens from the voter rolls, and to institute that process on an ongoing basis
- Request your lawmaker introduce legislation to require state IDs and drivers licenses to PROMINENTLY differentiate between citizens and noncitizens on the face of the card
- Institute DMV procedures to ensure that any noncitizen is BARRED from being registered to vote or offered voter registration opportunities
