## How All Electronic Tolling Works



- Gantries read E-ZPass transponders or license plates
- Cameras capture images for Toll By Plate invoices
- No stopping or slowing down required

#### Transitioning from Cash to All Electronic

- E-ZPass is the lowest-cost, most convenient option
- Sign up online, by phone, or visit the SJTA's Customer Service Center on the ACX (Milepost 21.3)
- Toll By Plate invoices mailed to registered owners



# How This Project Is Funded

- Funded entirely
   through previously
   issued toll revenue
   bonds
- No state or federal tax dollars used
- Repayment through toll revenues only



### Understanding the Difference


Toll By Plate customers pay more than E-ZPass users because of additional costs:

- Image processing
- Billing & postage
- Potential collections



### Proposed Toll By Plate Fees

IF YOU DON'T HAVE E-ZPASS YOU WILL PAY MORE THAN DOUBLE TO TRAVEL THE ATLANTIC CITY EXPRESSWAY



#### Proposed Toll By Plate Fees

- 100% Toll Surcharge
- \$1.00 Invoice Fee Per Bill
- \$5.00 Late Fee if Balance
   Not Paid within 30 Days

# Toll By Plate Workflow

#### First Toll Bill:

- Issued after \$50 in toll transactions or 30 days
- Amount includes all tolls plus \$1 invoice fee
- Due 30 days from date of issuance

#### Second Toll Bill:

- Failure to pay first Toll Bill results in second Toll Bill
- Amount includes all tolls and \$1 invoice fee from first Toll Bill plus a \$5 late fee
- Due 30 days from date of issuance

#### Failure to pay second Toll Bill:

Failure to pay second Toll Bill results in all toll transactions converting to violations. The violation process will remain unchanged from the current process established under N.J.A.C. 19:2–8.2 and will be the same for both E–ZPass and Toll By Plate customers. Other penalties could apply, up to and including motor vehicle registration suspension.
