## POLICIES

- The shuttle may deviate up to 1/8 of a mile off the route by reservation only. Call Customer Service, 856-227-7571, by 12:00 PM the day before traveling to make a route deviation reservation.
- Service is curb to curb. Drivers cannot exit the bus except to deploy the wheelchair lift.
- Shoes and shirts are required.
- Pets, smoking, eating, drinking, littering, profanity, or loud music not permitted.
- Harassment of riders or driver will not be tolerated.
- No shuttle service on New Year's Day (Observed), Memorial Day, Independence Day (Observed), Labor Day, Thanksgiving Day, and Christmas Day (Observed).

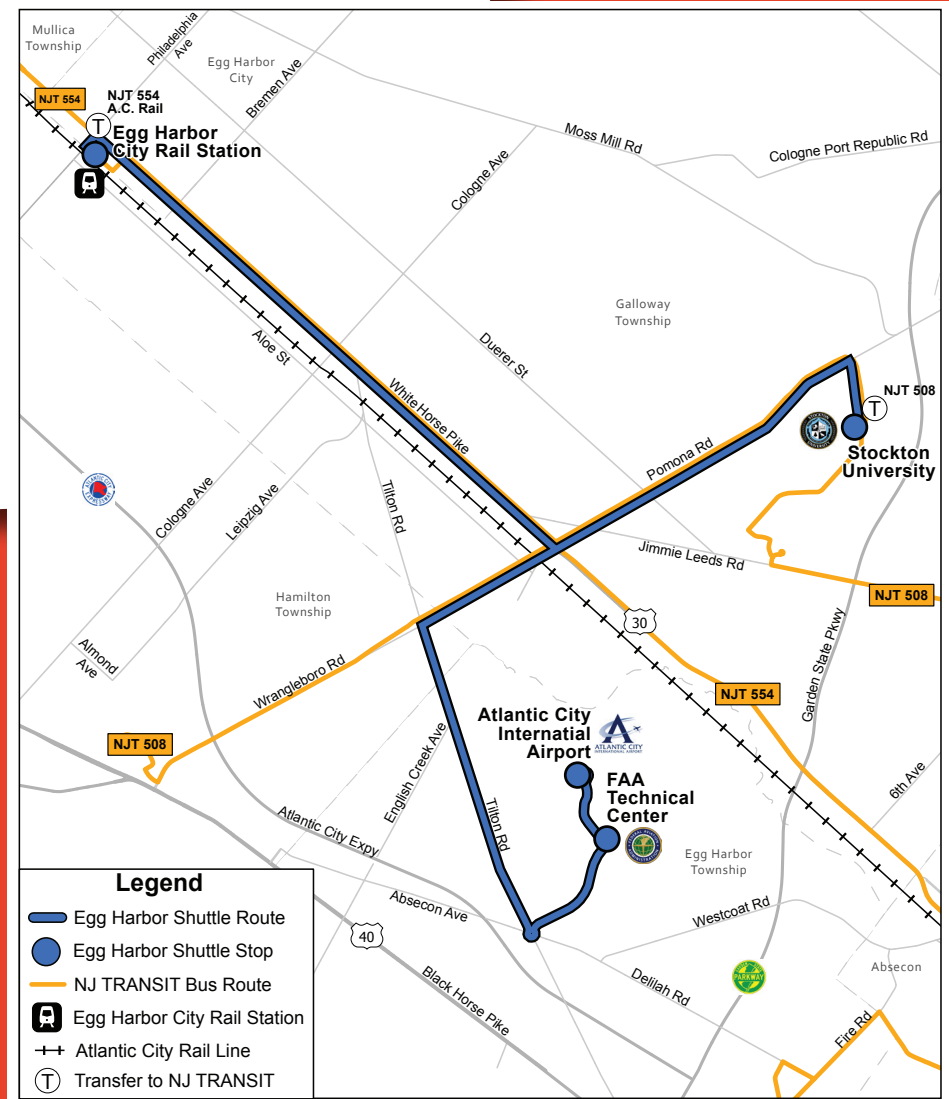
