Atlantic City Expressway

The South Jersey Transportation Authority (“SJTA” or “Authority”) is requesting **ELECTRONIC** proposals from engineering firms to perform various engineering services related to the safe and efficient operation of the SJTA’s facilities. The SJTA will engage an engineering consulting firm with roadway planning, design, and operational maintenance experience to perform a variety of services necessary for toll road operations, facilities maintenance and traffic tunnel systems initialization and maintenance.

This Request for Proposal will be available through Bid Express on **Wednesday, March 25, 2026 after 1:00 pm**. Electronic proposals shall be submitted through the Bid Express platform and are due on **Tuesday, April 21, 2026 at 2:00 pm****.

****Important Note:** The SJTA will only accept electronic bid/proposal submissions through the Bid Express electronic bidding portal. If you are not already registered for electronic submissions, please visit <https://www.bidexpress.com> in order to bid with the SJTA. To subscribe, follow the directions on the website. The fee schedule is available, and all fees are payable to Bid Express.

Any emailed, mailed or physical proposers delivered to the SJTA will not be accepted and/or will be returned to the bidder unopened.

The SJTA, in accordance with applicable law, reserves the right to reject any or all proposals and also to waive any minor informality or non-material exceptions in any proposal or proposals so received.

In making its selection, the SJTA shall consider criteria as follows:

- Experience of the Firm
- Experience of the Project Manager
- Key Personnel’s Qualifications and Experience
- Understanding of the Project
- Technical Approach
- Small Business Participation

Proposers are required to submit a current statement of qualifications and supporting data. To qualify for consideration, firms are required to submit prequalification status with a State of New Jersey Department or SJTA as outlined in the Request for Proposal document.

Proposers are also required to comply with the requirements of N.J.S.A. 10:5-31 et seq., N.J.A.C. 17:27 Mandatory Equal Employment Opportunity Regulations.
