\$6.00 cash fare. Exact fare required. Drivers do not carry money and can not make change.

NJ TRANSIT monthly 8 zone bus passes will be honored by SJTA for travel on the shuttle.

Reduced fare policy: \$3.00 for seniors, persons with a disability, or financial limitations. Passengers can show their driver's license, Medicaid card or NJ TRANSIT reduced fare card. Contact SJTA at 856-227-7571 for more information.

Service is curb to curb. Drivers cannot exit the bus except to deploy the wheelchair lift.

No bikes or personal scooters allowed in passenger compartment.

Shoes and shirts required.


