- **Ordinance #1580** (rezoning multiple properties to central business district) – *approved 6-0-0*
- **Ordinance #1582** (updates to rules for City Council meeting agendas) – *approved 6-0-0*
- **Ordinance #1581 – First Reading** (budget amendment for current fiscal year) – *approved 6-0-0*

- Fire Department software upgrades to improve emergency response - *approved 6-0-0*

- Design services for city projects: City Center, Aquatic Center, and Fire Station #2 - *approved 6-0-0*
