- Driveway culverts and drainage ditches within the right of way are maintained by the Public Works Department
- Culverts are owned by the property owner. At the property owner's request, the Public Works Department will aid in the replacement and installation of culverts within the City of Dickson's right of way. The property owner is responsible for the cost of all materials.
