



Guidelines for Brush Removal

The City of Dickson provides brush removal for city residents

- Brush is defined as shrub and tree trimmings and clippings
- We will pick up shrubs from which all dirt has been removed. Brush is collected on the City's right-of-way on a street by street basis-not by individual request
- The City of Dickson will remove one, single tree that is cut into pieces less than 6 foot in length and 12 inches in diameter. A bulk refuse fee will be imposed for the removal of more than one tree (Information regarding the bulk refuse fee can be found under Sanitation Division.)
- Brush is required to be placed in a neat, orderly manner-not protruding into the street.
- When a contract service is used by the property owner to remove brush, it is the responsibility of the contractor to dispose of the brush. There is a \$150.00 per load fee for the removal of brush work performed by a contract service.
