2. **RESOLUTION #2026-38: A Resolution Approving and Authorizing the City of Dickson to Participate in the Certified Tennessee Downtowns Program**

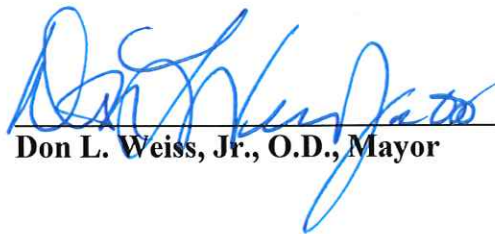
