

SUMMARY: Finance and Management Committee March 16, 2026

At its regular session March 16, 2026, the City of Dickson's Finance and Management Committee:

- Unanimously approved the minutes of the Jan. 22, 2026, Finance and Management Committee meeting and the check register for checks 103839-104615 with all members present;
- Approved a request by the Public Works Department to hire Zach Holland as a seasonal worker under the city's Nepotism Policy. He is the son of Parks and Recreation Department Program Coordinator Nikki Holland. The committee approved the request 6-1-1 with Councilperson Dwight Haynes (4th Ward) voting in opposition and Councilperson Michael Outlaw (4th Ward) abstaining; and
- Received a draft copy of the fiscal year 2024-2025 municipal audit. City Administrator David Travis said accountant Matt Wood of Alexander Thompson Arnold was unable to attend the meeting but will present the audit results at the April 6 council meeting. Mayor Don L. Weiss Jr. said a resolution to accept the audit will be presented at that time.

With no other business to come before the Finance and Management Committee, Mayor Weiss adjourned the meeting at 6:08 pm without objection with a special session of the City Council to follow.
