	A GREAT STATUE (DANIEL 2)	FOUR BEASTS (DANIEL 7)	A RAM AND A GOAT (DANIEL 8)
BABYLON (609–539 BC)	Head of pure gold // The king of Babylon (Daniel 2:32,38)	First beast: Like a lion with eagle's wings // An earthly kingdom (7:4,17)	—
MEDO-PERSIA (539–330 BC)	Chest and arms of silver // A kingdom inferior to Babylon (2:32,39)	Second beast: Like a bear raised up on one side // An earthly kingdom (7:5,17)	A two-horned ram, one horn longer // The kings of Media and Persia (8:3-4,20)
GREECE (330–63 BC)	Stomach and thighs of bronze // A third kingdom to rule the whole earth (2:32,39)	Third beast: Like a leopard with four wings and four heads // An earthly kingdom (7:6,17)	A goat with one large horn, later replaced by four horns (2) // The king of Greece; four weaker kingdoms arose after him (8:5-8,21-22; see also 11:2-20)
ROME (63 BC–)	Legs of iron; feet partly iron and partly fired clay // A fourth kingdom, strong but divided (2:33,40-43)	Fourth beast: Strong, with iron teeth; different from the others; ten horns (1) // A fourth earthly kingdom, different from the others; ten kings (7:7,23-24)	—
TYPES OF THE ANTICHRIST (see 2 Thessalonians 2:1-12; 1 John 2:18-23; Revelation 13:1-18)	—	(1) A little horn with an arrogant mouth emerged; it successfully warred against God's holy ones until it was killed and burned // A king different from the others; it spoke against God and His holy ones until the appointed time for his judgment (7:8-11,20-22,24-26)	(2) A little horn emerged and acted arrogantly against the Prince (God) and His sanctuary; for a time, it was successful // A ruthless king who successfully destroyed God's people until he was broken, but not by human hands (8:9-12,23-26; see also 11:21-45)
VISIONS OF THE CHRIST (see Matthew 24:30-31; 26:64; Luke 20:9-18; Revelation 1:1-20)	A stone, dislodged without human hands, crushed the statue and became a mountain filling the earth // God will set up a kingdom that will crush all other kingdoms and never be destroyed (2:34-35,44-45)	One like a son of man, on the clouds of heaven, received an everlasting, worldwide dominion from the Ancient of Days // The kingdoms of earth will be given to God's holy ones, and His kingdom will be everlasting (7:13-14,27)	—
