MIRACLE	WITNESS	PURPOSE	RESULT
Jesus Healed an Official's Son (John 4:46-54)	The official's servants and family in Capernaum; informed the official when he arrived home from Cana	To show Jesus had authority over illness	The official and his entire household believed in Jesus.
Jesus Drove Out an Unclean Spirit (Mark 1:21-26)	Everyone who was in the synagogue in Capernaum	To show Jesus had authority over the spiritual realm	The crowd was amazed, and the news about Jesus spread throughout the region.
Jesus Healed Simon Peter's Mother-in-Law (Mark 1:29-34)	The disciples and Peter's family	To show Jesus had authority over the physical world	She began to serve Jesus; many people brought to Jesus anyone who needed to be healed or freed from unclean spirits.
Jesus Healed a Leper (Mark 1:40-45)	The disciples and the man with leprosy	To show Jesus's power over illness and His obedience to the law	The healed man told everyone what Jesus did; therefore, He could not go into any towns because of the crowds.
Jesus Healed a Paralytic (Mark 2:1-12)	Everyone in the house as well as the Pharisees	To show Jesus had authority to forgive sins and to heal the sick	The crowd glorified God.
Jesus Healed a Man with a Shriveled Hand (Matthew 12:9-14)	Everyone who was in the synagogue, including the Pharisees	To show that Jesus, as Lord of the Sabbath, was not breaking the Sabbath by healing on that day	The Pharisees plotted to kill Him.
Jesus Raised a Widow's Son from the Dead (Luke 7:11-17)	The disciples, the crowd following Jesus, and the funeral procession	To show that Jesus had the power to raise the dead	The people feared and praised God and reported what had occurred.
