FAITH	JESUS'S RESPONSE	FORGIVENESS/ SALVATION/HEALING
The official approached Jesus in faith that He could heal his son, and he believed Jesus's word that his son was healed (John 4:46-47,50).	Jesus rebuked those who wanted to see signs, but when the official persisted, Jesus told him that his son was healed (John 4:48-50).	The official's servants told him the boy was healed the same time Jesus said it; the official and his entire household believed (John 4:51-53).
A centurion asked Jesus to heal his servant, having faith that Jesus didn't have to come to his house to heal him (Matthew 8:5-9).	Jesus commended the centurion's faith and said his servant was healed (Matthew 8:10-13).	The centurion's servant was healed at that moment (Matthew 8:13).
In faith, four friends brought a paralyzed man to Jesus and removed part of the roof to get him to Jesus (Mark 2:3-5).	Jesus, amazed at their faith, said his sins were forgiven and later healed his paralysis (Mark 2:5,11-12).	Jesus forgave the man's sin and healed the man completely, showing His divine authority to do both (Mark 2:6-12).
In faith, a sinful woman approached Jesus and washed His feet with her tears and hair (Luke 7:37-38,50).	Jesus commended her for her love for Him because of her many sins He had forgiven (Luke 7:44-47).	Jesus forgave her sins, declared her to be saved, and told her to go in peace (Luke 7:48-50).
Jairus came to Jesus asking Him to help his daughter, who was dying (Mark 5:22-23).	Jesus went with him, and when people told Jairus his daughter was dead, Jesus said not to be afraid but to believe (Mark 5:24,35-36).	Jesus raised the 12-year-old girl to life (Mark 5:38-42).
A woman with a bleeding condition touched Jesus's hem (Mark 5:25-28).	Immediately Jesus felt power go out from Him (Mark 5:29-30).	Woman was healed, and Jesus said her faith saved her (Mark 5:29,34).
Two blind men followed Jesus, calling out for mercy (Matthew 9:27).	Jesus asked if they believed He could heal them, and they replied yes (Matthew 9:28).	Jesus healed their eyes, according to their faith (Matthew 9:29-30).
A Canaanite woman begged Jesus to save her demon-possessed daughter and kept pleading when He did not respond (Matthew 15:22-23).	Jesus told her He had been sent to the lost sheep of Israel, but she persisted in faith (Matthew 15:24-28).	Jesus said her faith was great, and He healed her daughter (Matthew 15:28).
