



ENCOUNTERING JESUS



PERSON	ENCOUNTER	HOW THEY WERE CHANGED
Nicodemus (John 3:1-21)	Met with Jesus at night to speak with Him	Believed in Jesus, though he kept it hidden for fear of the Jews
The Samaritan Woman (John 4:1-42)	Met Jesus at noon at the well and spoke with Him	Believed Jesus is the Messiah; told her community, who also met Him and believed
The Syrophenician Woman (Mark 7:24-30)	Begged Jesus to heal her daughter and persisted in faith despite His first answer	Her daughter was healed; her faith in Jesus is implied (cf. Matthew 15:28)
A Man Born Blind (John 9:1-41)	Received healing from Jesus and was questioned by the Pharisees	Banned from the synagogue, but he worshiped Jesus as Messiah and Lord
A Rich Young Ruler (Luke 18:18-23)	Asked Jesus what he must do to inherit eternal life	Went away sorrowful because he was unwilling to give up his possessions
Zacchaeus, a Chief Tax Collector (Luke 19:1-10)	Climbed a tree to catch a glimpse of Jesus; Jesus went to his house and dined with him	Repented of his sins, pledging to support the poor and to pay back four times what he had extorted
Judas Iscariot (Matthew; Mark; Luke; John)	Spent roughly three years with Jesus, learning from Him and witnessing His miracles, including His resurrection power	Secretly was a thief who betrayed Jesus for thirty pieces of silver
The Apostles (Matthew; Mark; Luke; John)	Spent roughly three years with Jesus, learning from Him and witnessing His miracles, including His death and resurrection	Trusted Jesus as Lord and Savior and took the gospel to the nations
