



JESUS'S END TIMES TEACHINGS



PROPHECY	"NOW" / HISTORICAL FULFILLMENT	"NOT YET" / FUTURE FULFILLMENT
Destruction of the Temple (Mark 13:2)	Rome destroyed the city of Jerusalem and the temple in AD 70.	Daniel 9:24-27 may mean the antichrist will allow the Jews to rebuild the temple only for him to desecrate it before the end (2 Thessalonians 2:1-4).
False Messiahs Will Arise (vv. 6,21-22)	An Egyptian revolted against Rome (Acts 21:38). Ancient historians mentioned men like Theudas and Simon bar Kosiba who claimed to be the Messiah. ¹	The beast/antichrist will recover from a mortal wound (Revelation 13:1-8); a second beast will perform miracles to deceive (vv. 11-15).
Wars and Rumors of War (vv. 7-8)	Jews rebelled against Rome in AD 66, ultimately leading to first Jewish-Roman War c. AD 66-74.	The rider on the red horse will take peace from the earth (Revelation 6:4).
Earthquakes and Famines (v. 8)	Earthquake at crucifixion (Matthew 27:50-51) and resurrection (28:2); famine (Acts 11:27-28)	Violent earthquakes (Revelation 6:12; 8:5; 11:13; 16:18) and famine (18:8) in God's judgments
Persecution (vv. 9-13)	Believers were arrested (Acts 5:18; 8:3; 12:4-5; 16:23-24) and killed (7:57-60; 12:2).	Believers are and will continue to be killed for their faith (Revelation 6:9-11; 11:7-10)
Gospel Preached to All Nations (v. 10)	Believers took the gospel to Jews (Acts 2:41; 4:2), Samaritans (8:5), and Gentiles (8:34-38; 9:15; 10:45; 11:18; 13:48) throughout the known world.	People from every tribe, tongue, and nation will be redeemed (Revelation 5:9-10; 7:9-10).
The Temple Desecrated (v. 14)	Caligula attempted to erect a statue in the temple in AD 40. Titus defiled the most holy place in AD 70.	The man of lawlessness, the antichrist, will set up his seat in the temple (2 Thessalonians 2:3-4).
Tribulation (vv. 14-20)	Siege and destruction of Jerusalem in AD 66-70, which scattered the Jews throughout the Roman Empire	The dragon, Satan, will wage war against believers (Revelation 12:17); the beast, the antichrist, will persecute and conquer the saints for a time (13:7).
Sun, Moon, Stars Affected (vv. 24-25)	Darkness came over the land during Jesus's crucifixion (Mark 15:33).	Sun, moon, and stars darkened by the judgment of God (Revelation 8:12)
The Lord Will Return to Gather His People (vv. 26-27)	—	Jesus will return and all people will see Him (Revelation 1:7; 19:11-16); He will judge the living and the dead (20:11-15); and His people will live with Him forever (21:3-4).
