FIRST SIGN	Water into Wine (John 2:1-12)	Jesus asked for six jars to be filled with water, and the water became wine.	Jesus's disciples; the servants	Jesus's glory as the Son of God (2:11)	His disciples believed in Him (2:11).
SECOND SIGN	Healing an Official's Son (4:46-54)	Jesus, in Cana, told the official his son, in Capernaum, would live.	Royal official and his household	Jesus's power to heal by word	The official and his household believed in Jesus (4:53).
THIRD SIGN	Healing a Paralytic (5:1-18)	Jesus told the man at the pool of Bethesda to pick up his mat and walk.	The man and the Jews who criticized him carrying his mat	Jesus's authority over the Sabbath as God the Son (5:18)	The Jews plotted to kill Jesus (5:16,18).
FOURTH SIGN	Feeding the 5,000 (6:1-15)	Jesus gave thanks, then distributed the five loaves and two fish, feeding all and having leftovers.	The disciples and the 5,000 men, plus women and children	Jesus is greater than Moses as the Bread of Life (6:14,32-35)	The crowd wanted to make Jesus king, but He withdrew from them (6:15).
FIFTH SIGN	Walking on Water (6:16-21)	At night, Jesus walked on the Sea of Galilee to the disciples' boat.	The disciples	Jesus's power over nature and His identity as "I am" (6:20; Exodus 3:14)	The disciples were afraid but took Jesus on board in faith (6:19,21).
SIXTH SIGN	Healing a Man Born Blind (9:1-41)	Jesus spit on the ground, made mud, put it on the man's eyes, and told him to wash in pool of Siloam.	The disciples, the man, his neighbors, his parents, and the Pharisees	God's glory in the man's healing (9:3) and Jesus's messiahship (9:33)	The man believed in and worshiped Jesus (9:38).
SEVENTH SIGN	Raising Lazarus from the Dead (11:1-53)	In Bethany, Jesus prayed and called Lazarus out of the tomb.	The disciples, Mary, Martha, and the Jews mourning with them	Jesus's glory as the Son of God (11:4)	Many believed, but the Jewish leaders plotted to kill Jesus (11:45-53).
