How to Use These Cards

Open your Bible to the Scripture reference and review the Bible story with your kids. Collect these cards to help your kids understand the Bible chronologically.

Use the review questions to prompt dialogue with your kids and make connections between the Bible story and the world around them.



Jesus' Second Miracle

John 4

Bible Story Summary:

After returning to Cana, Jesus was approached by a royal official pleading for his dying son to be healed. Jesus declared, "Your son will live," and the man believed; later, the official learned his son recovered at the exact moment Jesus spoke, leading his whole household to believe in Him.

Review Questions:

- What does the official's response teach us about having faith in God's promises?
- How does this story show Jesus' power as God?



Jesus Rejected in Nazareth

Luke 4

Bible Story Summary:

In His hometown of Nazareth, Jesus read from the scroll of Isaiah in the synagogue and declared that the prophecy was fulfilled in Him. The people were amazed but skeptical. After Jesus pointed out that prophets are often rejected in their own towns, they became angry and tried to drive Him out. Jesus safely escaped.

Review Questions:

- What did Isaiah's prophecy say about Jesus?
- Do you believe that Jesus is the Messiah? Why?



Healings in Capernaum

Mark 1; Luke 4

Bible Story Summary:

While in Capernaum, Jesus taught in the synagogue with authority and cast out an unclean spirit from a man, astonishing the crowd. He then healed Simon's mother-in-law and others who were sick or possessed. News of His power quickly spread throughout the region.

Review Questions:

- How was Jesus' teaching different from the religious leaders?
- How does Jesus' kindness in healing people help us understand what God is like?



Healings in Galilee

Mark 1; Luke 4–5

Bible Story Summary:

After healing many in Capernaum, Jesus rose early to pray alone. He continued healing and casting out unclean spirits throughout Galilee, including cleansing a man with leprosy, which led to crowds seeking Jesus—even as He often withdrew to pray.

Review Questions:

- What does Jesus' example teach us about the importance of prayer?
- How does Jesus physically healing people point to what He did on the cross?



Jesus Forgives and Heals

Matthew 9; Mark 2; Luke 5

Bible Story Summary:

Jesus returned to Capernaum, where a crowd gathered to hear Him teach. Four men lowered their paralyzed friend through the roof to reach Him. Jesus forgave the man's sins and healed him, astonishing everyone and proving His authority to forgive and heal.

Review Questions:

- How did the four men and their friend show faith?
- How did Jesus reveal that He is God?



Jesus Chose Disciples

Mark 2–3; Luke 6

Bible Story Summary:

While teaching by the sea, Jesus called Levi to follow Him, and Levi immediately did. Later, Jesus explained to critics why He ate with sinners, saying He came to call the spiritually sick, and after spending a night in prayer, Jesus chose twelve disciples to follow Him.

Review Questions:

- Why did Jesus spend time with sinners?
- What is a way you can follow Jesus this week?



The Lord of the Sabbath

Matthew 12; Mark 2–3; Luke 6

Bible Story Summary:

While walking through grain fields on the Sabbath, Jesus defended His disciples for picking grain by teaching that mercy is more important than ritual, and that He is Lord of the Sabbath. Later, He healed a man with a shriveled hand in the synagogue, showing it is merciful to do good on the Sabbath. This angered the Pharisees.

Review Questions:

- Why is mercy more important to God than sacrifice?
- Why did God create the Sabbath and command us to rest?



Jesus' Sermon on the Mount

Matthew 5–7; Luke 6

Bible Story Summary:

As large crowds followed Him, Jesus went up a mountain and taught about living in God's kingdom—encouraging righteousness, love for enemies, prayer, and trust in God's care. Jesus concluded by urging people to build their lives on His teachings like a wise man building on solid rock. This left the crowd amazed at His authority.

Review Questions:

- How can our actions point others to God?
- How should knowing that God cares for us help us feel peace?



John the Baptist in Prison

Matthew 11, 14; Mark 6; Luke 3, 7

Bible Story Summary:

King Herod put John the Baptist in prison because John told Herod he was disobeying God. While in prison, John asked Jesus if He was the Messiah. Jesus affirmed His identity through miracles and praised John as a great prophet.

Review Questions:

- How did Jesus show that He is the Messiah?
- What does this story teach about standing for truth, even when it is hard?



Jesus Raised a Widow's Son

Luke 7

Bible Story Summary:

As Jesus approached the town of Nain, He saw a widow mourning her only son, who had just died. Moved with compassion, Jesus told the young man to get up, and he was miraculously restored to life, causing the crowd to glorify God and spread news of the miracle throughout the region.

Review Questions:

- How did Jesus show His love and care for people in this story?
- Why were the people amazed?



Jesus Was Anointed

Luke 7

Bible Story Summary:

Simon the Pharisee invited Jesus to dinner at his house, where a sinful woman lovingly washed Jesus' feet with her tears and perfume. Jesus used the moment to teach about forgiveness, explaining that those who are forgiven much love much. He also told the woman her sins were forgiven and her faith had saved her.

Review Questions:

- How did the woman show her love for Jesus?
- What did Jesus teach Simon about forgiveness?



Jesus Taught about Prayer

Luke 11, 18

Bible Story Summary:

Jesus taught His disciples how to pray, emphasizing humility, persistence, and trust in God's goodness. Through parables, Jesus showed that God hears those who pray sincerely and that those who humble themselves before Him will be lifted up.

Review Questions:

- Why does Jesus tell us to keep praying to God and not give up?
- What does Jesus' prayer and parables teach us about how much God loves to hear from His children?



Jesus Taught about Possessions

Luke 12

Bible Story Summary:

As Jesus taught a crowd, He warned against greed. He told a parable about a rich man who stored up wealth but died before enjoying it, urging people to focus on God. Jesus encouraged His disciples not to worry about material needs but to seek God's kingdom first, store treasure in heaven, and trust in the Father's care.

Review Questions:

- How do Christians store up treasure in heaven?
- What does this story teach us about how God takes care of us and why we don't need to worry?

The Gospel: God's Plan for Kids

God rules. God created everything, and He is in charge of everything.
(Gen. 1:1; Col. 1:16-17)

We sinned. Everyone sins, or disobeys God. Our sin separates us from God.
(Rom. 3:23; 6:23)

God provided. God sent His Son, Jesus, to take the punishment we deserve.
(John 3:16)

Jesus gives. He died in our place and rose again. (Rom. 5:8; 2 Cor. 5:21)

We respond. We are saved when we turn from sin and trust in Jesus.
(Rom. 10:9-10,13)
