**PURPOSE:**

To provide limited Financial Assistance to a student who is a member of Holy Savior Parish or to a Child or Grandchild or relative of an active member of the Daughter of Isabella, St. Timothy Circle, #504, for the furthering of their education.

**SCHOLARSHIP AWARDS:**

Scholarships are awarded based to students who are members of Holy Savior Parish (inclusive of St. A&J in Rumford and Our Lady of the Snows in Bethel), or to a child/grandchild/relative of an active member of the Daughters of Isabella, St. Timothy Circle, #504.

The amount of the scholarships will be determined by the Scholarship Committee of the Daughters of Isabella, St. Timothy Circle # 504.

## REQUIREMENTS:

A Child or Grandchild or relative of a Daughter of Isabella, St. Timothy Circle #504 members in good standing.

A member of Holy Savior Parish (inclusive St. Athanasius – St. John Church in Rumford and Our Lady of the Snows in Bethel.

A graduating high school senior or a student returning to a college or technical school to further their education.

Proof of acceptance to a college, university or Technical School.

5. A 250-500 word essay, written by the applicant, demonstrating knowledge of THE IMPORTANCE OF THE TEACHINGS OF JESUS CHRIST IN THE LIFE OF THE STUDENT.

## OTHER RELATED INFORMATION

1. Payments of Scholarship Awards will be awarded after winning applicants supply grades for 1<sup>st</sup> semester.

2. Scholarship announcements will be made by Daughters of Isabella Scholarship Committee no later than June 1st, 2026

Please be sure your application and essay are legible and complete. Incomplete applications will not be considered. The decision of the committee is final.
