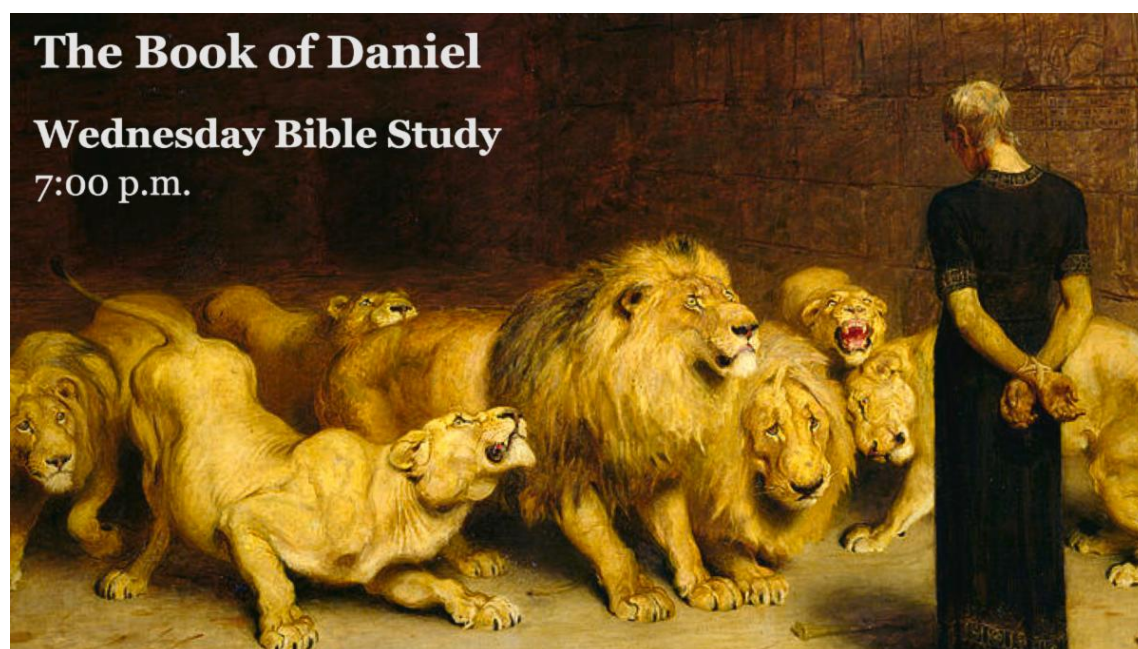

7:00 p.m.

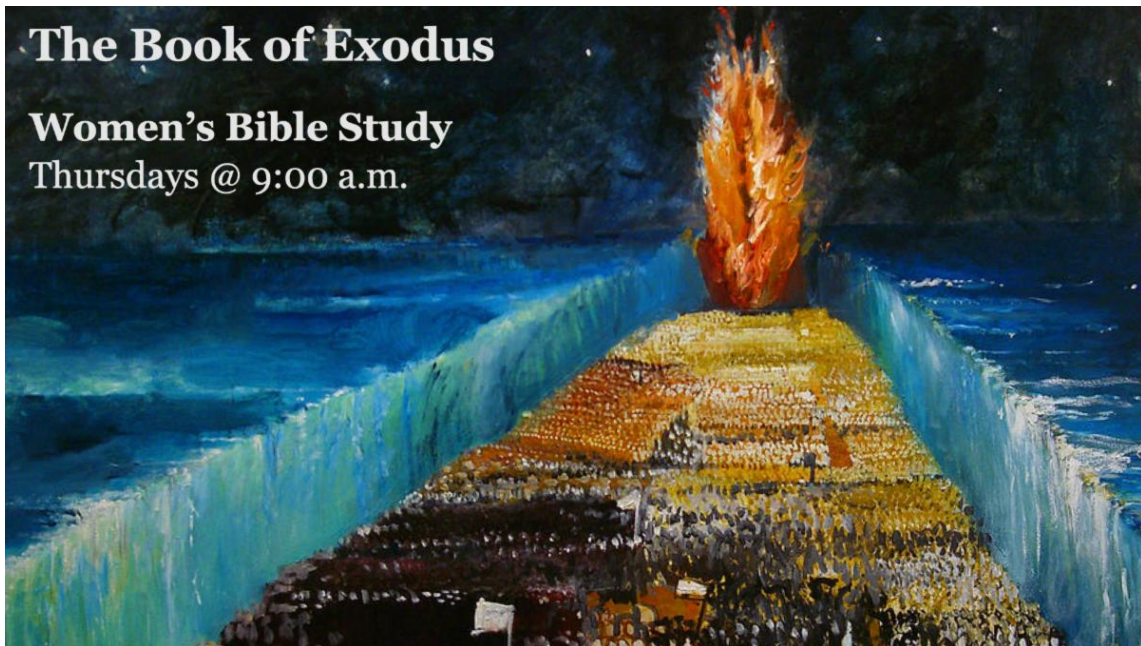

At those fairs, hundreds of our members as well as many visitors from our community were exposed to the many ways that they can serve God through our congregation. One of the striking things at a past ministry fair were the observations of those that were visiting from our sister congregations and community. One of those visitors stated:

“This ministry fair is so impressive. This is exactly the type of thing that my home congregation has been talking about doing. We would love to have a ministry fair that so glorifies God just like the one Faith is having now.”

Occasionally, people will comment how “our congregation used to do things better” or “our congregation doesn’t do some things as well as some neighboring churches.” Although there may be some truth to those statements, it is also true that God is doing many wonderful things at Faith right now! Although we may not always have that perspective, it was very apparent to those who visited our past ministry fairs.

In planning a Faith ministry fair, our primary goal was to strengthen the connections between our members and Christ. However, it is now apparent that God also used our ministry fair to inspire His people to have ministry fairs in other places as well. It is very likely that God will use those other ministry fairs to lead even more people to Him. In other terms, although we intended the ministry fair to primarily benefit our members and the Antioch community, God used our ministry fair to touch the lives of many more people than in just our immediate community. What an Awesome God we have!

On **Sunday September 14**, Faith will again host a ministry fair that will showcase many of our ministries here at Faith as well as numerous other ministries that we are associated with through our membership in the Wisconsin Synod. **The ministry fair will begin at 10:30 a.m. (immediately after the worship service ends) and will last until 11:30 a.m.** Our congregation sponsors a ministry fair only once every three or four years, so don't wait for the next one to happen! We invite everyone to attend this ministry fair to see the many different opportunities that are available for them to serve Christ.

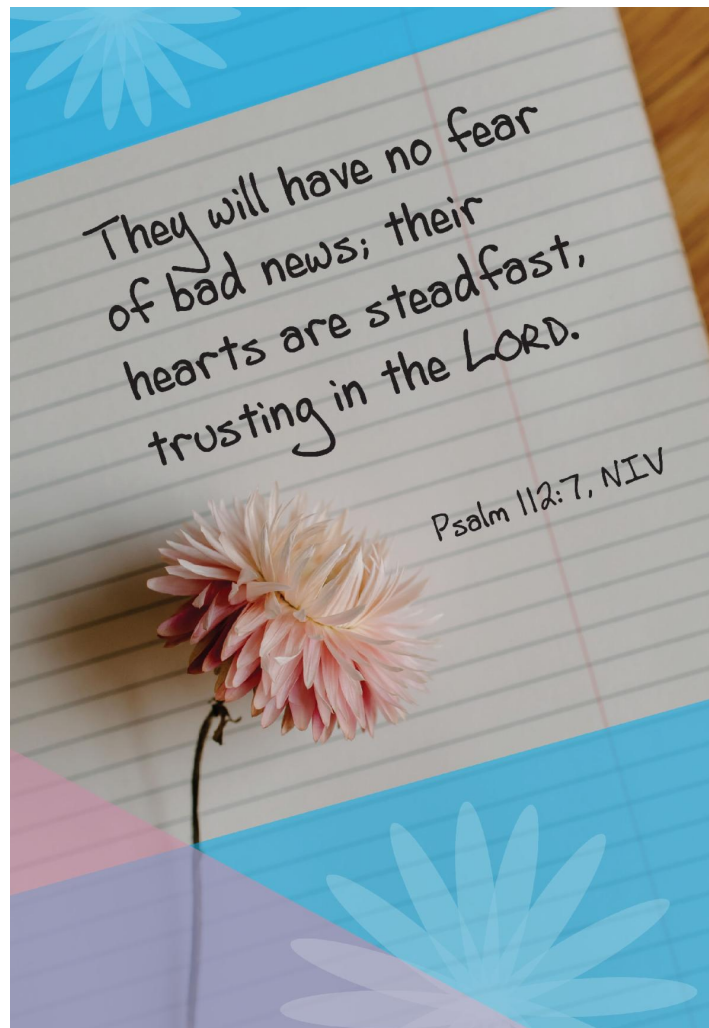

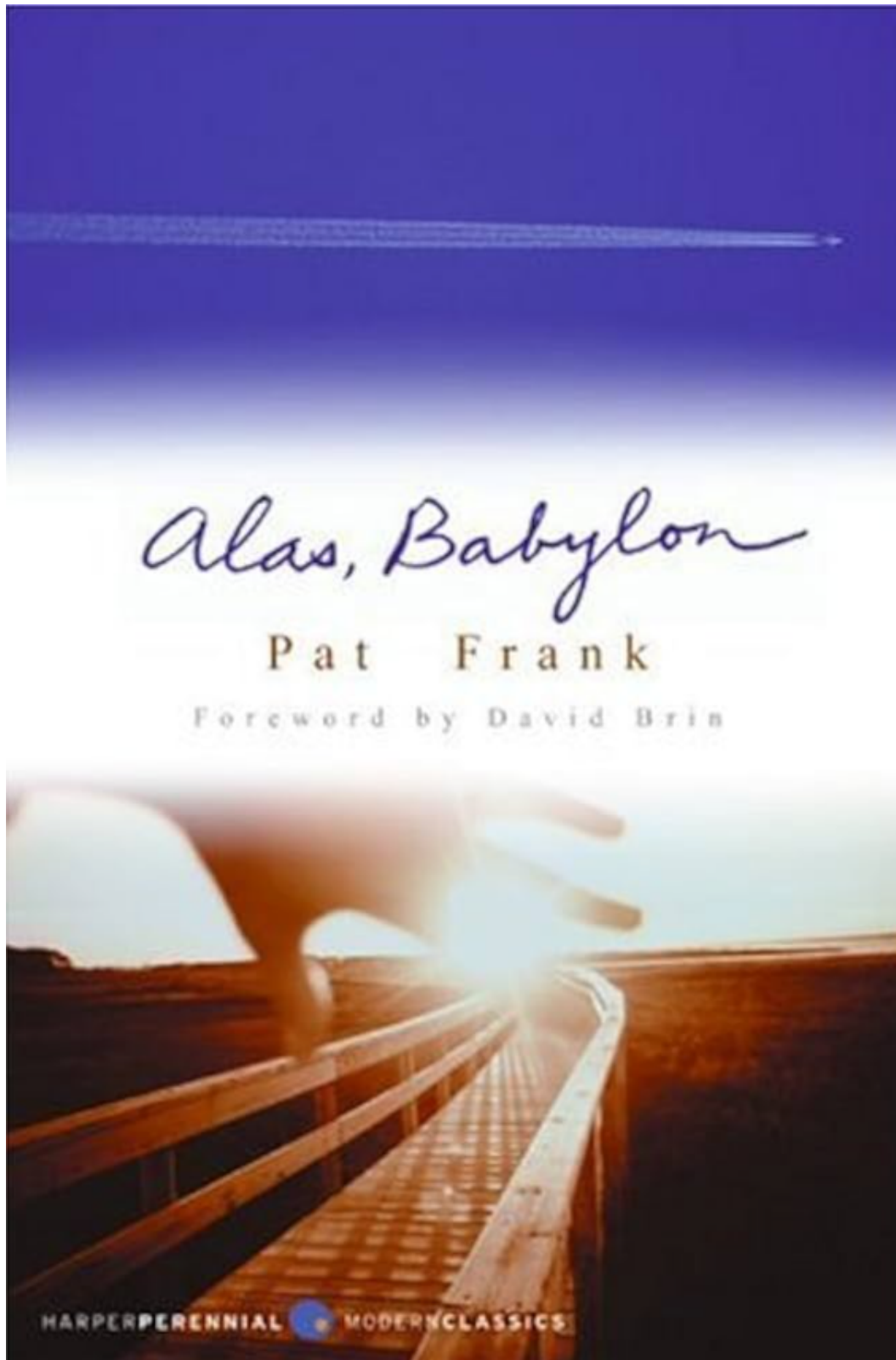

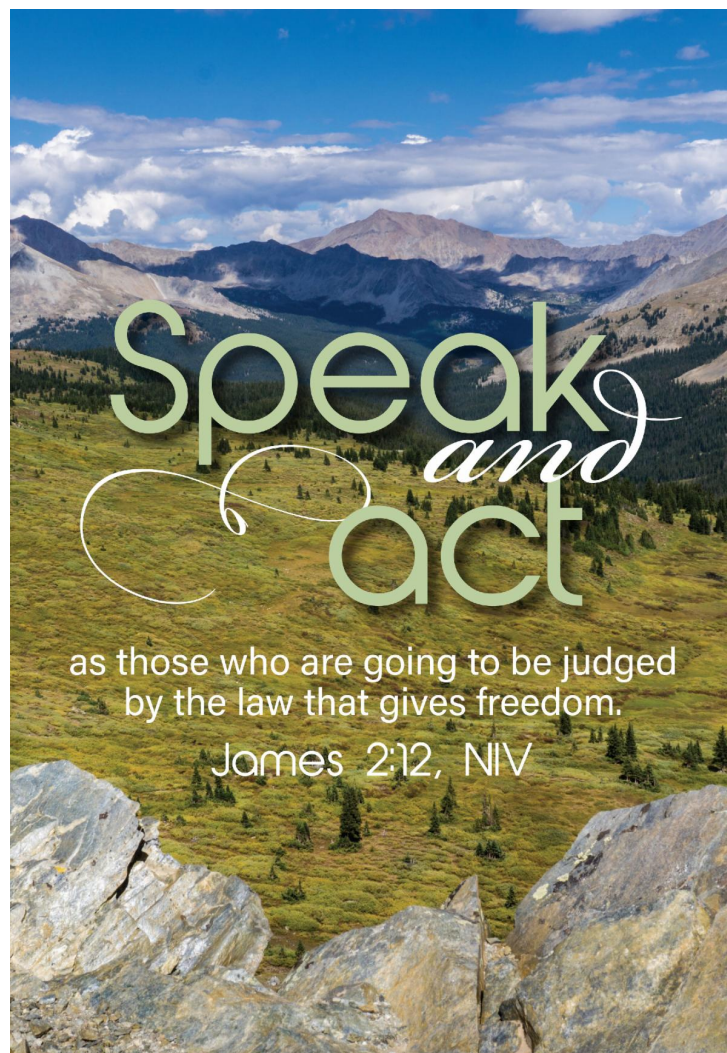
