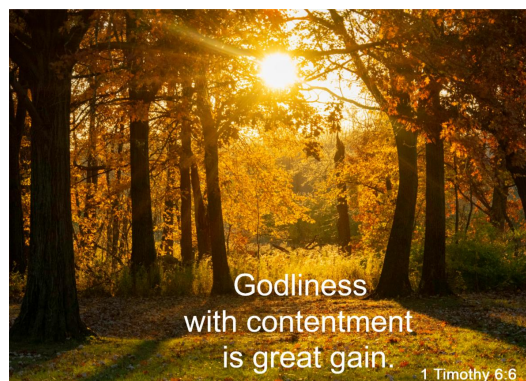

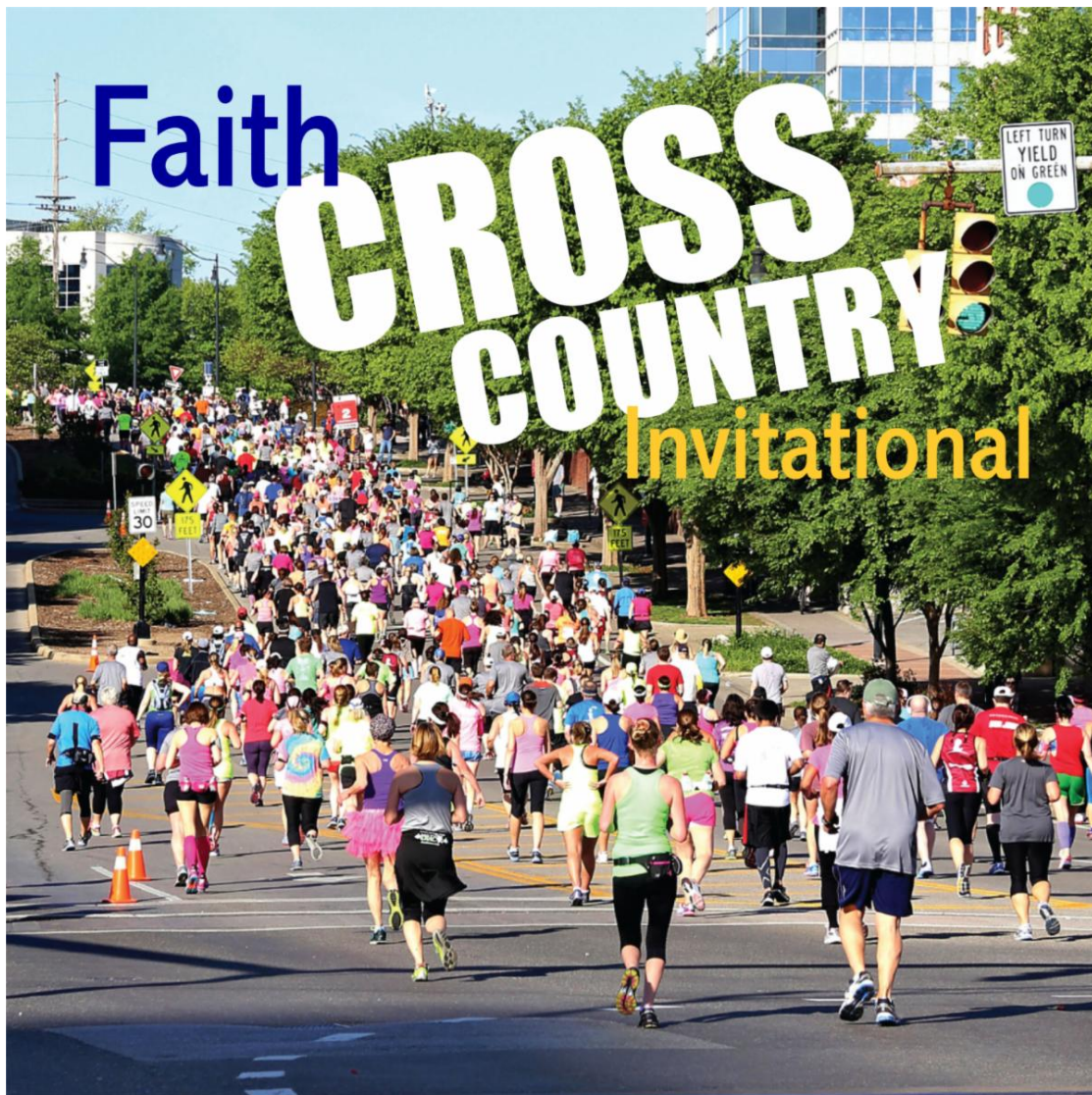
WHEN AND WHERE TO TURN IN PRIZES

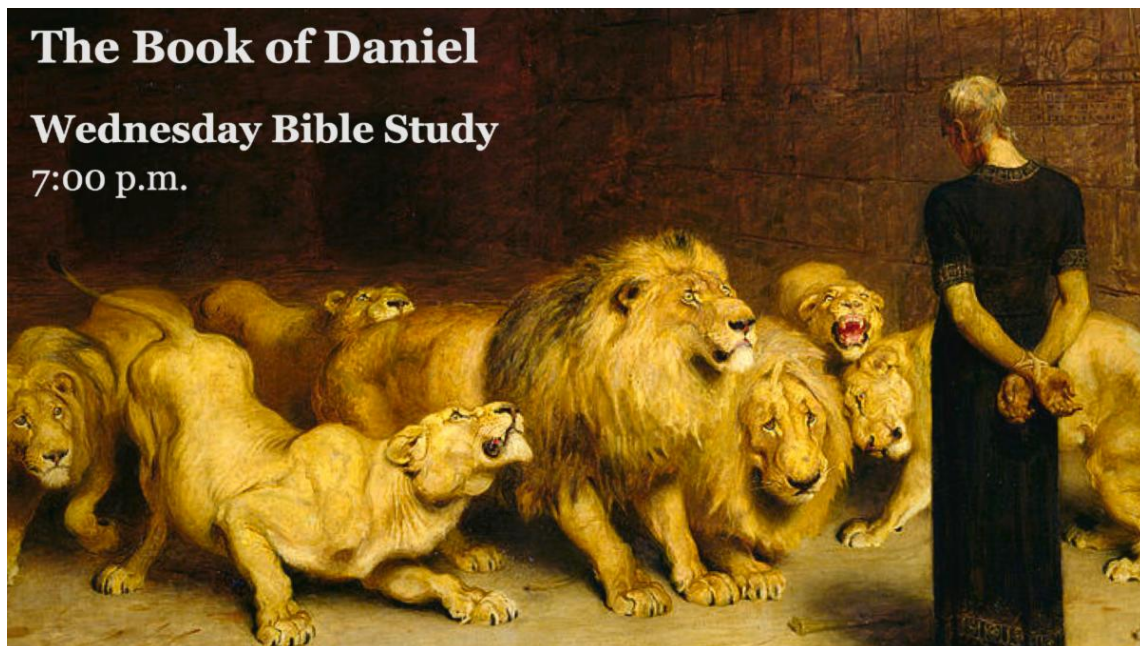
MINISTRY FAIR - THANK YOU!

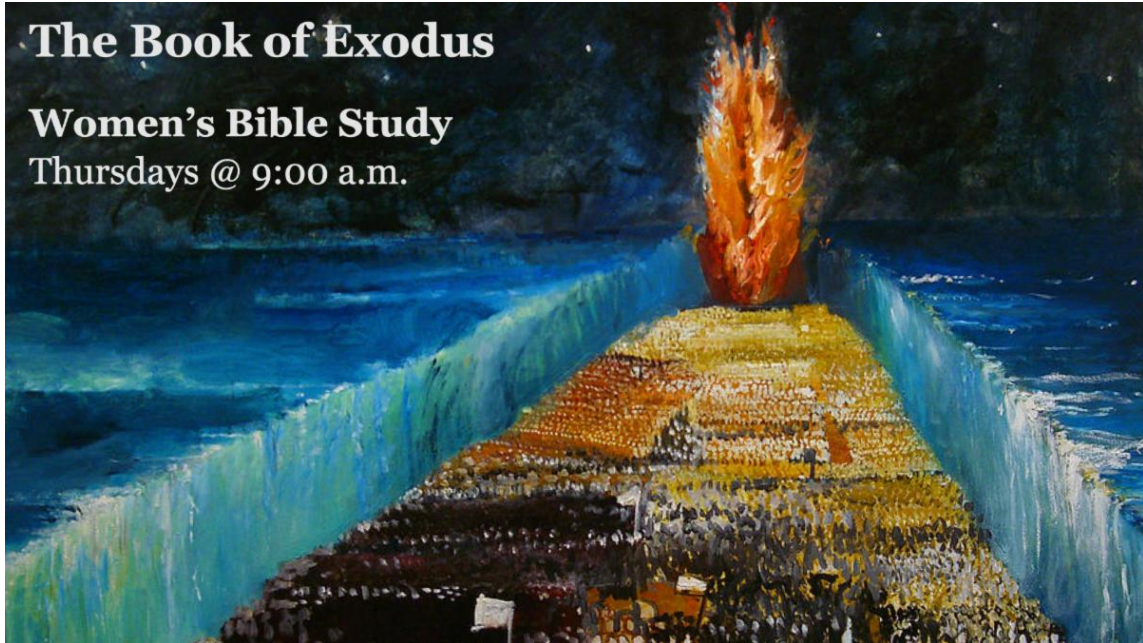

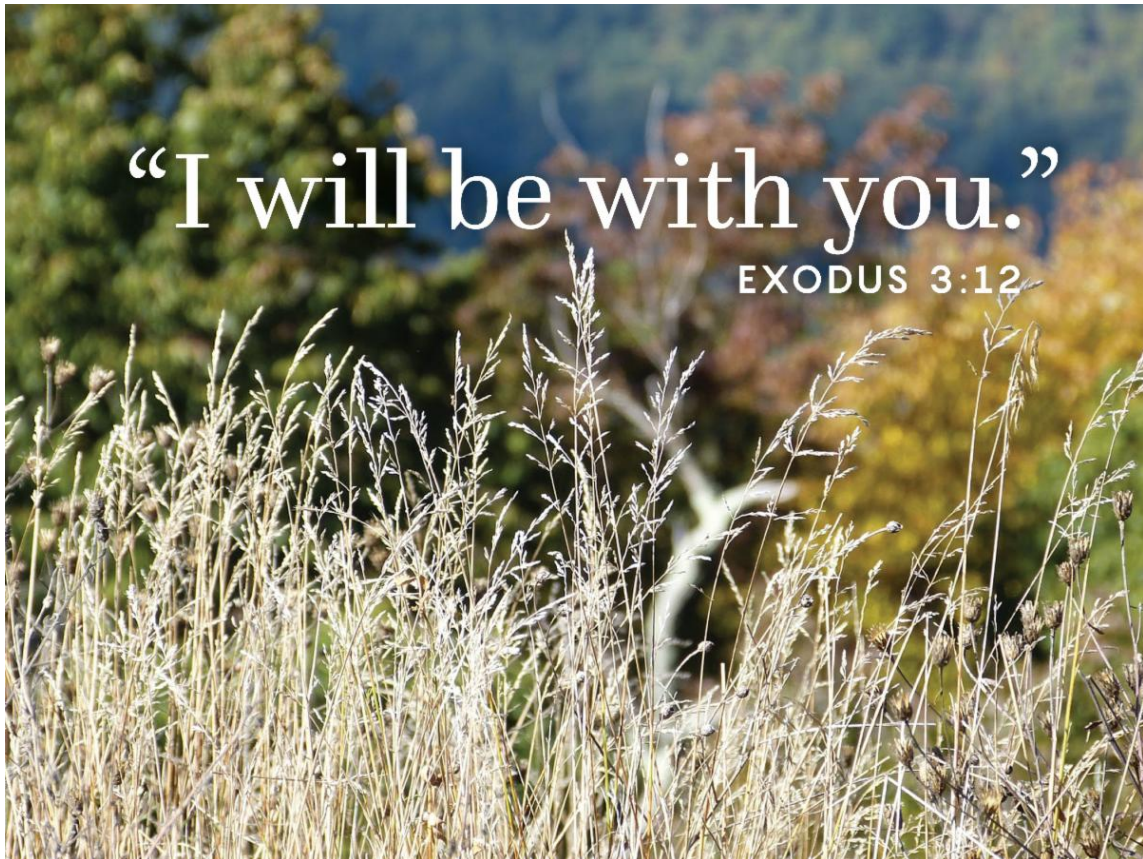

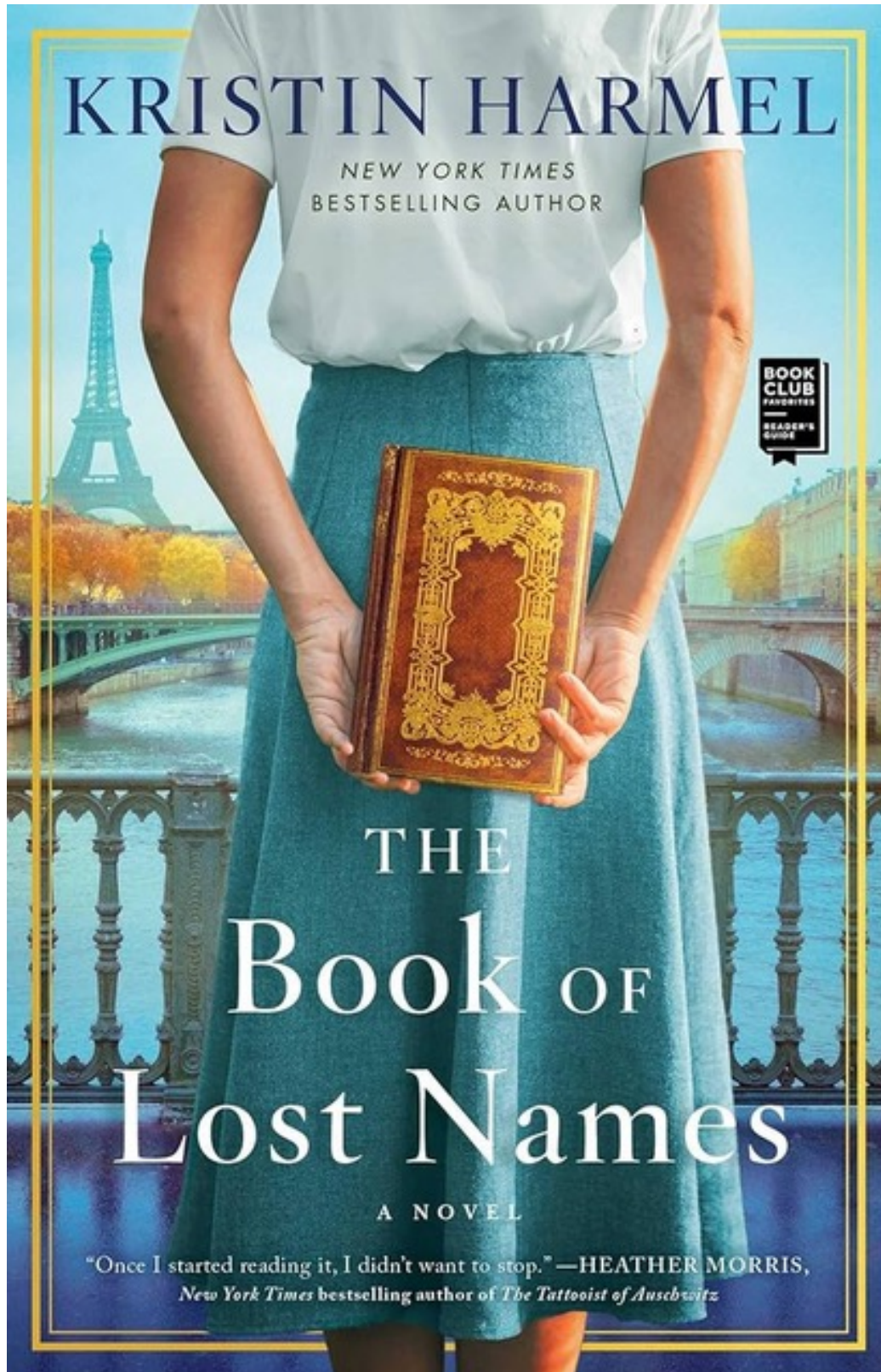

Lord, Hear Our Prayers

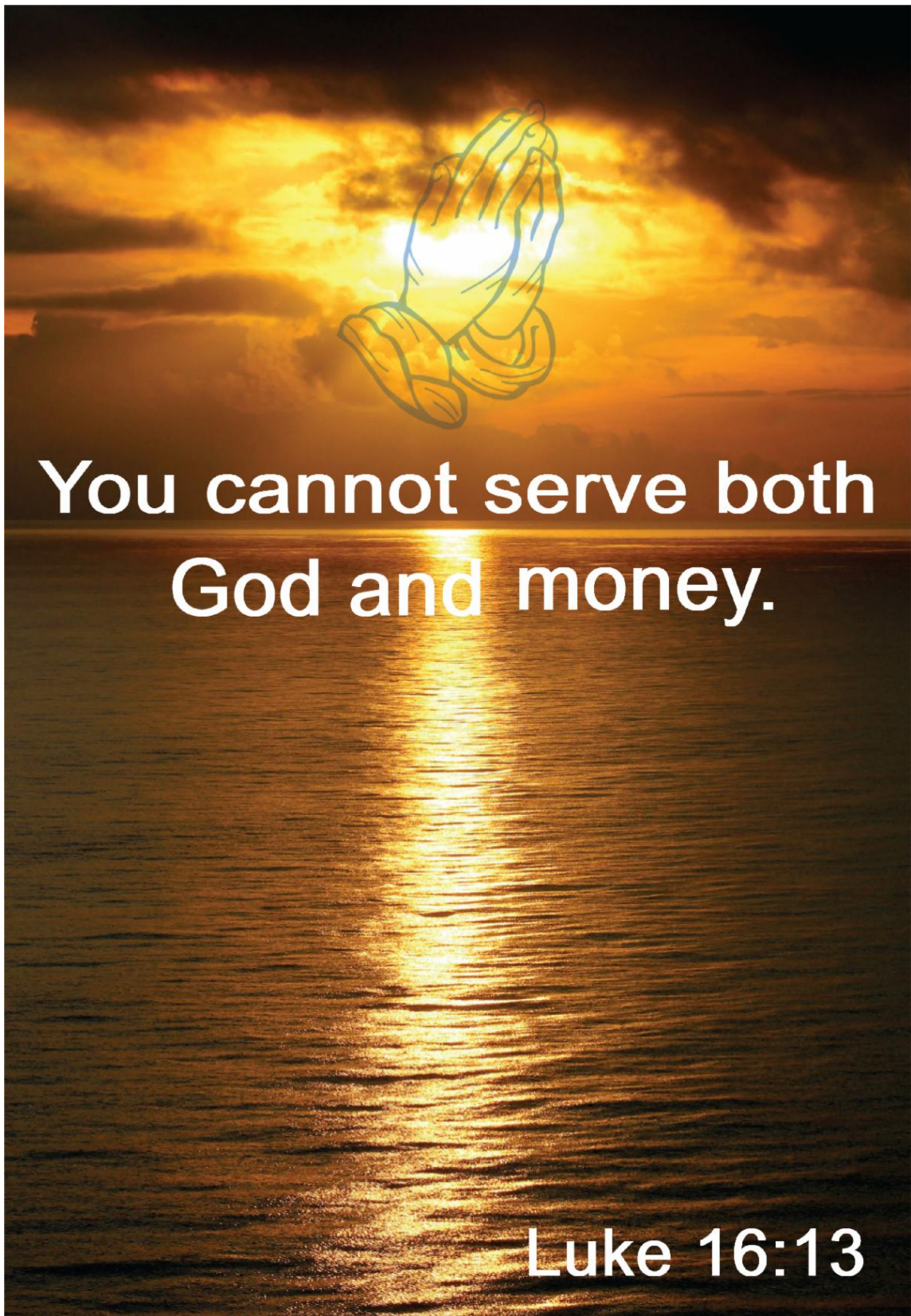
