




FALL FESTIVAL - THANK YOU!

Thank you all for making this past weekend a possibility. Through your prayers and participation, we were able to share the love of Jesus to many from the Antioch area and beyond.


A special thanks to all those who baked, donated, and volunteered for stations, set up, and food service. You served your congregation and your Savior well.





Wednesday, October 15th, at 11:00 a.m.




Lord, Hear Our Prayers
