

As Christ burst forth from the tomb, may new life burst forth from us and show itself in acts of love and healing to a hurting world.



"Manifesto: The Mad Farmer's Liberation Front," a famous poem by renowned poet Wendell Berry ends with two simple words: "Practice Resurrection."




Practice Resurrection: Volunteer. Find an opportunity to volunteer your time and use your gifts and abilities to bring life and possibility to a cause.


Prayer: Thank you God for the history and stories of our faith and for the gift of water. AMEN.



Prayer: May the story of Christ's Resurrection inspire and empower us all the days of our life. AMEN.




