

# STANDARDISED PRICE LIST

All funeral directors are legally required to publish this Price List for a standardised set of products and services. This is to help you think through your options and make choices, and to let you compare prices between different funeral directors (*because prices can vary*).

## ATTENDED FUNERAL

(funeral director's charges only) **£1799**

This is a funeral where family and friends have a ceremony, event or service for the deceased person at the same time as they attend their burial or cremation.

Taking care of all necessary legal and administrative arrangements	<b>£1202</b>
Collecting and transporting the deceased person from the place of death (normally within 15 miles of the funeral director's premises) into the funeral director's care	<b>£120</b>
Care of the deceased person before the funeral in appropriate facilities. The deceased person will be kept at the funeral director's premises	<b>£1</b>
Providing a suitable coffin – this will be a traditional oak veneered coffin	<b>£295</b>
Viewing of the deceased person for family and friends, by appointment with the funeral director (where viewing is requested by the customer)	<b>£1</b>
At a date and time you agree with the funeral director, taking the deceased person direct to the agreed cemetery or crematorium (normally within 20 miles of the funeral director's premises) in a hearse or other appropriate vehicle	<b>£180</b>

## UNATTENDED FUNERAL

This is a funeral where family and friends may choose not to have a ceremony, event or service for the deceased person, but they do not attend the burial or cremation itself.

**Burial** (funeral director's charges only) **£1799**

**Cremation** (funeral director's charges plus the cremation fee)<sup>2</sup> **From £1250**

## FEES YOU MUST PAY

For an Attended or Unattended burial funeral, the **burial fee**<sup>1</sup>. **Price on Request**

In this local area, the typical cost of the burial fee for local residents is: **Price on Request**

For a new grave, you will also need to pay for the plot; for an existing grave with a memorial in place, you may need to pay a removal/replacement fee. In addition, the cemetery may charge a number of other fees.

For an Attended cremation funeral, the **cremation fee**. **£939**

In this local area, the typical cost of a cremation for local residents is: **£939**

**ALL SEASONS**  
INDEPENDENT FUNERAL DIRECTORS

[1] This fee (which is sometimes called the interment fee) is the charge made for digging and closing a new grave, or for reopening and closing an existing grave.

[2] In England, Wales and Northern Ireland, you will usually need to pay doctors' fees as well. This is the charge for two doctors to sign the Medical Certificates for Cremation.
