5. **Public Comment:** *Individual members of the public may address the Board for a maximum of three minutes on items not on the current agenda. In accordance with the Texas Open Meetings Act, any response to a public comment that is made on an item that is not on the published final agenda will be limited to a statement of information or a statement of existing policy given in response to the public comment. Any deliberations or decision by the Board must be limited to a proposal to place the subject on a future agenda.*

6. **Public Comment on Agenda Items:** *Individual members of the public may address the Board for a maximum of three minutes, per agenda item. Individuals may address the Board once per item. Members of the public will speak on an agenda item after comments on the item are called for by the presiding officer, but before Board decision and consideration of the item. Members of the public should make the Board aware of the agenda items on which they want to speak by completing the sign-in form before the meeting.*
