Dear Parents and Carers,

We are very proud to offer a broad curriculum to the children at Northwold. While we continue to build children's knowledge and confidence in reading, writing and maths, we also nurture their talents and skills in the arts.

Our Art curriculum is designed to help children to reach their full potential and equip them with the knowledge and skills that allow them to celebrate some of the highest forms of human creativity. It is designed to engage, inspire and challenge pupils while equipping them with the skills and the confidence to invent, create, experiment and discuss critically their work. They are taught to value the contribution that art makes to wider society and how art has captured and shaped our country's history and culture.

In lessons, children learn about an artist and the techniques they use before creating their own pieces of art using a range of materials and tools. Year 5 and 6 are currently developing their skills in the use of clay as a medium, Year 4 are using charcoal, Year 3 are developing embroidery skills while Year 1 and 2 are developing their understanding and use of colour. Expressive arts and design in the early years offers our youngest children weekly opportunities to build musical, artistic and creative skills.

We also offer a wide range of music at the school – every class has an hour of music each week, with half an hour of that dedicated to learning an instrument. This year, we are offering the following instrumental lessons to all children:

Year 3 and 6 – Violin Year 4 and 5- Ukulele Year 1 and 2 – Percussion

We also have a very strong choir who are currently working towards performing in the Young Voices concert at the O2 as part of a larger group of school choirs. There will be opportuni-

ties through the school year to come and see our musicians perform – please keep a look out for dates in the school calendar.

This week we invited our reception parents to their first 'bring your parent to school' morning. It was a great opportunity to see learning in action.

Thank you to the parents who joined the phonics coffee morning this morning. I hope that you found it informative and that you have some strategies to take away to support your children at home.

Next week we have our open day for new reception parents (2026-2027). We welcome all our nursery parents to the 9:30am meeting. Please spread the word to family and friends who may be interested in finding out about our curriculum. We also have a coffee morning on the Friday 10th October for nursery parents – please join us to find out about learning in the nursery and 2-year-old provision.

We have our footballers taking part in a tournament in Hackney on Wednesday. We wish them the best of luck. Our athletes will be taking part in an inter-school competition with the other Arbor Trust schools on Wanstead Flats next Friday. This is a fantastic opportunity to take part in competitive sports and grow skills in sportsmanship. Good luck to all taking part.




School Trips
