**Hope Collaborative respectfully requests \$5,000 from the Oldham County Fiscal Court to support Court Diversion Workshops.**

**About Hope Collaborative:** Hope Collaborative provides programming for children and adults across the Greater Louisville area, following the mission: *Through purposeful relationships, we love children and families to inspire hope.* We operate three primary programs in support of this mission: Public School Outreach to offer school-based mentoring; Hope Place community center; and Court Diversion workshops for teens through a partnership with the Juvenile Administrative Offices of the Courts.

**The Need:** Youth who become justice-involved often face significant barriers throughout their lifetime. Without early intervention and supportive programs, these young individuals are at higher risk of continued cycles of violence and dangerous behavior. According to the *Kentucky Youth Advocates 2019 Data Book*, between 2016 and 2018, Kentucky saw 7.6 youth incarcerated in the juvenile justice system per 1,000 children—a rate that worsened compared to 2011-2013. This statistic underscores the need for programs that address root causes of delinquency and provide resources to help youth avoid future involvement with the justice system. By implementing supportive interventions early on, we can promote healthier development and prevent repeat offenses.

**Use of Funds:** Funding from OCFC will support Hope Collaborative’s Court Diversion Workshops. We offer these workshops in partnership with the Juvenile Administrative Offices of the Courts. Youth in this program have been charged with either misdemeanors or low-level felonies, with charges ranging from drugs, alcohol, burglary, shoplifting, and criminal mischief.

Workshops meet once a week for eight weeks. During each session, students and leaders share a meal while connecting with each other through conversation. Students discuss their role in creating a safe and thriving community while learning about a specific subject related to their charges. Our goal is to empower students so that they can learn from their mistakes and move toward a future filled with hope.

We offer workshops in three locations across Greater Louisville, including the Oldham County Court Designated Worker. We anticipate serving 44 Oldham County students in 2024 and have already reached 28 across seven cohorts. We hope to serve at least 40 students in 2025. According to survey responses, 50% of participating youth desired to change as a person and 45% positively impacted their community after completing the program.

**Project Budget:** The annual budget for the Court Diversion program is \$39,900. The majority of expenses (\$28,900) are personnel expenses for salaries and continuing education. We also spend \$1,000 annually on curriculum, \$1,500 on Dare to Care/Food expenses, and \$750 on volunteers. A

grant of \$5,000 from OCFC will support a portion of salary expenses and volunteer expenses related to this location.
