The Oldham County Fiscal Court convened at 1:04pm, for a special called meeting, with Judge-Executive David Voegelé, County Attorney Berry Baxter, and the following magistrates were in attendance: Brent Likins, Wayne Theiss, Kevin Woosley, Kevin Jeffries, Chris Haunz, Bob Dye and Michael Logsdon. Magistrate Stephanie Hawkins was absent.

APPROVAL OF AGENDA:

Motion made by Magistrate Haunz and seconded by Magistrate Woosley to approve the agenda, as presented. Motion carried unanimously. **Exhibit #1 4/27/2026**

COUNTY CORONER COMPENSATION:

County Coroner, David Pendleton, presented to the court his request for an increase of \$10,000. **Exhibit #2 4/27/2026** Discussion followed.

Motion made by Magistrate Woosley and seconded by Magistrate Theiss to approve the \$10,000 pay increase request, plus the CPI. Discussion followed.

Motion made by Magistrate Jeffries to amend the requested increase amount to \$8,000. Motion failed with no second.

Motion made by Magistrate Jeffries and seconded by Magistrate Haunz to amend the original motion to approve an increase request amount to \$2,500 per year over the next 4 years, plus CPI. Motion passed on roll call vote, 5-3 with Magistrates Theiss, Woosley and Logsdon voting no.

The Court proceeded to vote on the original motion, as amended. Motion passed 5-3 Magistrates Theiss, Woosley and Logsdon voting no.

COUNTY ADMINISTRATION:

Road Department Equipment Purchase

Motion made by Judge Voegelé and seconded by Magistrate Jeffries to approve the invoice for the front loader, purchased from Boyd CAT, for \$174,129.08, after trading in another piece of equipment for a \$52,000 credit towards the total cost of \$226,129.08. Motion carried 7-1, Magistrate Woosley voted no.

COMMUNITY BUSINESS:


1st Reading of FY27 Budget – KOC 26-220-5
