The Evansville Philharmonic begins its 2026-2027 season with a program that celebrates brilliance, lyricism, and the excitement of a new musical year. Quinn Mason's *Inspiration! — A Festive Overture for Orchestra* launches the evening with vibrant orchestral color, setting a joyful and energetic tone.

Howard Hanson's beloved Symphony No. 2, "*Romantic*," follows with sweeping melodies and warm, glowing harmonies. One of the most treasured American symphonies, its lush sound world offers an immersive and deeply expressive experience.

The program also features Brahms' powerful Double Concerto for Violin and Cello, performed by husband-and-wife duo Lucia Micarelli on violin and Eric Byers on cello. Their artistry brings passion and intimacy to this dramatic musical dialogue. Audiences may also recognize Micarelli from her starring role in the Hallmark Channel film *The Christmas Bow*, her extensive touring with singer Josh Groban, and appearances in all four seasons of the HBO series *Treme*.

The *Classical Jukebox* concert is a high-energy tour of orchestral favorites, bringing together some of the most recognizable music ever written — all in one memorable evening. Like a perfectly curated playlist, this program pulses with both romance and rhythm, moving effortlessly across styles and eras. From the elegance of Mozart and the delightful charm of Haydn's "Surprise" Symphony to the warmth and lyricism of Brahms' Symphony No. 3, "Poco allegretto," and the brilliance of Handel's *Royal Fireworks Music*, each work showcases the expressive heartbeat of the orchestra.

Verdi's Overture to *Nabucco* adds sweeping operatic drama, while Barber's *Adagio for Strings* offers a moment of profound romance and reflection. The journey continues with the iconic drive of Beethoven's Fifth Symphony, "Allegro" and concludes in spectacular fashion with the power of John Williams' score to the film *Star Wars: The Force Awakens*. Surrounded by the rich acoustics and grandeur of the Victory Theatre, this concert is an immersive celebration of music's ability to move us — through both its passion and its pulse.

This performance welcomes Orchestra alumni to the stage and honors the memory of former Music Director Stewart Kershaw.

The program concludes with Poulenc's exuberant *Gloria*, a collaboration for the Evansville Philharmonic Orchestra, Chorus, and soprano. Both reverent and playful, this masterpiece celebrates the joy, beauty, and grandeur of the sacred in a thrilling and deeply human expression of praise.

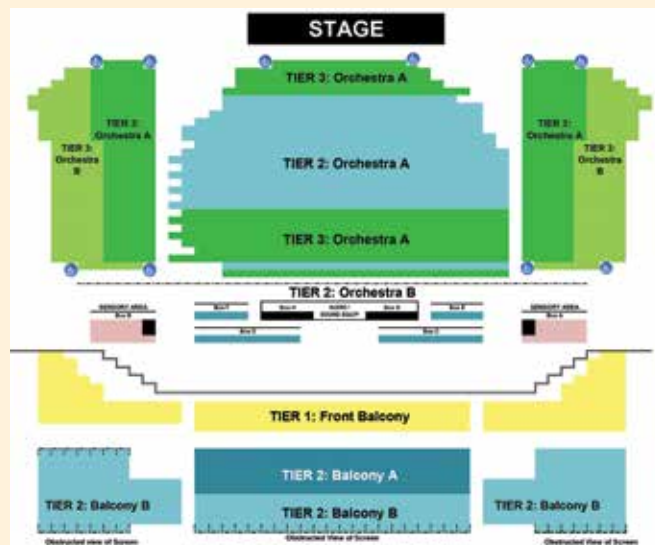
